On September 6th, Air Force Capt. Orchydia Sackey, a St. Croix native, and an Educational Complex graduate was welcomed with a water salute by V.I. Port Authority's airport rescue firefighters upon her arrival back home to St.Croix from MacDill Air Force Base's 6th Air Refueling Wing.

During her stay, Sackey, 27, who flew a KC-135 Stratotanker from MacDill, Florida met with local youth shared her journey with students, and discussed military career opportunities. Sackey is a graduate of the U.S. Air Force Academy, nominated by former Virgin Islands Delegate to Congress Donna M. Christian. "She is an inspiration to our young, aspiring aviators in this territory and proves that the sky truly is the limit," Port Authority Executive Director Carlton Dowe said according to a VI Port Authority announcement.
