APPLICANTS GENERAL INFORMATION

Applicants may apply for all scholarships for which they qualify. The application will open for submission on March 15, 2026, and will close at 11:59 on April 15, 2026. All packets must be submitted electronically, and no late packets will be accepted.

NOTE: Do NOT send packets by U.S. Postal Service mail.

SCHOLARSHIP RULES, PROCEDURES AND REQUIREMENTS

ELIGIBILITY

- Applicants must be an American citizen.
- Applicants must be a High School Senior.
- Hold a 2.8 or higher GPA on a 4.0 scale.
- 20 hours of community service (waivable if an applicant is an all-year athlete or participates in other extracurricular school activities, including a job. Must provide a letter from coach/supervisor).
- Any applicants who meet the above requirements may apply for the CW5 Julian A. Evans III Richard Anthony Scholarship.

- To apply for the CW5 Julian A. Evans III Military BRATS Scholarship you must be a child of a current active duty member, Veteran, Reservist or National Guardsman
- To apply for the CW5 Julian A. Evans III Eagle Rising Scholarship, your household income must be 60K or under.

REQUIREMENTS

CW5 Julian A Evans III Scholarship applicants must submit the following:

- A completed CW5 Julian A. Evans III scholarship application packet. Ensure all forms are completed and all questions answered. There should be no blanks. Where the information does not apply, mark it as N/A.
- Official high school transcript.
- Report Card (second semester – 2025-2026 Academic Year).
- High school activities sheet. The Activity Sheet should reflect school and community activities and any awards and recognition you have received in these activities. If your school does not provide an activities sheet, please request a letter of activities from your guidance counselor.
- Two letters of recommendation that speak on the character, integrity, and uniqueness of the student (cannot be from relatives)

For example, an applicant may highlight their desire to be a journalist. The multimedia Project allows each applicant to express their creative and intellectual prowess. The multimedia project must be prepared using one or more of the following: photographs, PowerPoint presentations, maps, stories, facts, quotations, sound clips, videos, and virtual reality tours on a specific topic prepared using a computer (digital).

Multimedia projects are due on April 15, 2026, no later than 11:59 p.m. *ONLY EXCEPTIONS ARE EMERGENCY CIRCUMSTANCES!!!* Any Multimedia Project submitted after 11:59 p.m. is considered late and will disqualify the applicant for Scholarships and Multimedia judging. Applicants submitting a **Multimedia Project** after the deadline must submit it to cw5jaeiiiisolarshipfoundation@gmail.com with written justification. All projects will be submitted electronically.

***NOTE: Applicants are encouraged to be as creative as possible with projects.**

Please type a 500 double spaced, APA format essay addressing the following:

1. Who is CW5 Julian A. Evans III, and what impact did he make on the lives of others and yours after completing your research about him?
2. Describe who you are, what you like to do, and how you see your career goals impacting the world.
3. Why are you the best candidate for this scholarship?
