

SUMMARY RESULTS OF THE MEMBER SATISFACTION & ENGAGEMENT SURVEY

We got the results of the Member Survey and I wanted to provide feedback to the membership since it will be key to developing a long term strategic plan so we can not only improve the club building as well as enhancing the member experience. Thank you all for your participation in the survey.

Overall Satisfaction

- "Satisfied" or "Very Satisfied": ~77% of respondents are content with their club experience.
- Neutral to Dissatisfied: ~23% express room for improvement.
