Proposed Auxiliary 4272 By-laws changes:

3.1(a) The fees for membership by initiation/application in conformity with Section 1.4 of the ladies' rules and regulations of the Fraternal Order of Eagles or laws amendatory thereof, shall be Twenty dollars (\$20.00)

3.1(d) The fee for issuance of a transfer card shall be Twenty dollars (\$20.00)

5.4(1) Dues of a dual member shall be Twenty dollars (\$20.00) per year.

6.2(2) When an auxiliary member is hospitalized for at least one (1) day, the auxiliary shall provide a gift card, cost not to exceed One hundred dollars (\$100.00) to be paid from the general fund when available and not more than once per fiscal year.

6.2(3) On the death of an Auxiliary's immediate family member (i.e. spouse, significant other, son, daughter, brother or sister) the auxiliary will provide a gift card, cost not to exceed One Hundred dollars (\$100.00) to be paid from the general fund when available.

10.1(1) In appreciation of services rendered by the retiring Madam President the Auxiliary, may by resolution adopted by the auxiliary present some suitable gratuity to the retiring Madam President. Cost not to exceed One Hundred dollars (\$100.00)

10.5 The Auxiliary moves to dissolve the position of Outside Guard

AERIE BY-LAW CHANGES TO BE VOTED ON MARCH 14, 2024

• RESOLVED: THAT SECTION 3.1A OF THE BY-LAWS BE REVISED SO THAT THE SAME WHEN AMENDED SHALL READ AS FOLLOWS: THE FEE FOR APPLICATION FOR MEMBERSHIP SHALL BE TWENTY DOLLARS (\$20.00)

CURRENTLY READS: THE FEE FOR APPLICATION FOR MEMBERSHIP SHALL BE FIFTEEN DOLLARS (\$15.00)

INTENT OF THE CHANGE: TO INCREASE THE AMOUNT OF APPLICATION FEE

• RESOLVED: SECTION 5.3 OF THE BY-LAWS BE REVISED SO THAT THE SAME WHEN AMENDED SHALL READ AS FOLLOWS: DUES OF NON-BENEFICIAL MEMBERS OF THE AERIE SHALL BE FORTY DOLLARS (\$40.00) PER YEAR, PRORATED ON A MONTHLY BASIS AND PAYABLE IN ADVANCE.

CURRENTLY READS: DUES OF NON-BENEFICIAL MEMBERS OF THE AERIE SHALL BE THIRTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$35.00) PER YEAR, PRORATED ON A MONTHLY BASIS AND PAYABLE IN ADVANCE.

INTENT OF THE CHANGE: TO INCREASE THE DUES OF NON-BENEFICIAL MEMBERS.

• RESOLVED: THAT SECTION 3.6 OF THE BY-LAWS BE REVISED SO THAT THE SAME WHEN AMENDED SHALL READ AS FOLLOWS: ANY FORMER MEMBER OF ANY AERIE SHALL BE ELIGIBLE FOR RE-ENROLLMENT AS A MEMBER IN GOOD STANDING. THE RE-ENROLLMENT FEE SHALL BE TWENTY DOLLARS (\$20.00). THE ANNUAL DUES OF FORTY DOLLARS (\$40.00) SHALL BE PRORATED ON A MONTHLY BASIS AND SUBMITTED WITH THE APPLICATION FOR RE-ENROLLMENT

CURRENTLY READS: ANY FORMER MEMBER OF ANY AERIE SHALL BE ELIGIBLE FOR RE-ENROLLMENT AS A MEMBER IN GOOD STANDING. THE RE-ENROLLMENT FEE SHALL BE TEN DOLLARS (\$10.00). THE ANNUAL DUES OF THIRTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$35.00) SHALL BE PRORATED ON A MONTHLY BASIS AND SUBMITTED WITH THE APPLICATION FOR RE-ENROLLMENT

INTENT OF THE CHANGE: TO INCREASE THE AMOUNT OF RE-ENROLLMENT APPLICATION FEE AND DUES

• RESOLVED: THAT SECTION 3.1B OF THE BY LAWS BE REVISED SO THAT THE SAME WHEN AMENDED SHALL READ AS FOLLOWS: THE FEE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF A TRANSFER CARD SHALL BE TWENTY DOLLARS (\$20.00)
