 2024- RESOLVED: THAT SECTION 3.1A OF THE BY-LAWS BE REVISED SO THAT THE SAME WHEN AMENDED SHALL READ AS FOLLOWS: THE FEE FOR APPLICATION FOR MEMBERSHIP SHALL BE TWENTY DOLLARS (\$20.00)
CURRENTLY READS:THE FEE FOR APPLICATION FOR MEMBERSHIP SHALL BE FIFTEEN DOLLARS (\$15.00)
INTENT OF THE CHANGE: TO INCREASE THE AMOUNT OF APPLICATION FEE
- RESOLVED: SECTION 5.3 OF THE BY-LAWS BE REVISED SO THAT THE SAME WHEN AMENDED SHALL READ AS FOLLOWS: DUES OF NON-BENEFICIAL MEMBERS OF THE AERIE SHALL BE FORTY DOLLARS (\$40.00) PER YEAR, PRORATED ON A MONTHLY BASIS AND PAYABLE IN ADVANCE.
CURRENTLEY READS: DUES OF NON-BENEFICIAL MEMBERS OF THE AERIE SHALL BE THIRTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$35.00) PER YEAR, PRORATED ON A MONTHLY BASIS AND PAYABLE IN ADVANCE.
INTENT OF THE CHANGE: TO INCREASE THE DUES OF NON-BENEFICIAL MEMBERS.

THE ANNUAL DUES OF THIRTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$35.00) SHALL BE PRORATED ON A MONTHLY BASIS AND SUBMITTED WITH THE APPLICATION FOR RE-ENROLLMENT
INTENT OF THE CHANGE: TO INCREASE THE AMOUNT OF RE-ENROLLMENT APPLICATION FEE AND DUES
