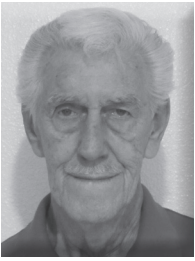
Our battles change, we suffer setbacks and sometimes even defeats, but we must celebrate the wins!

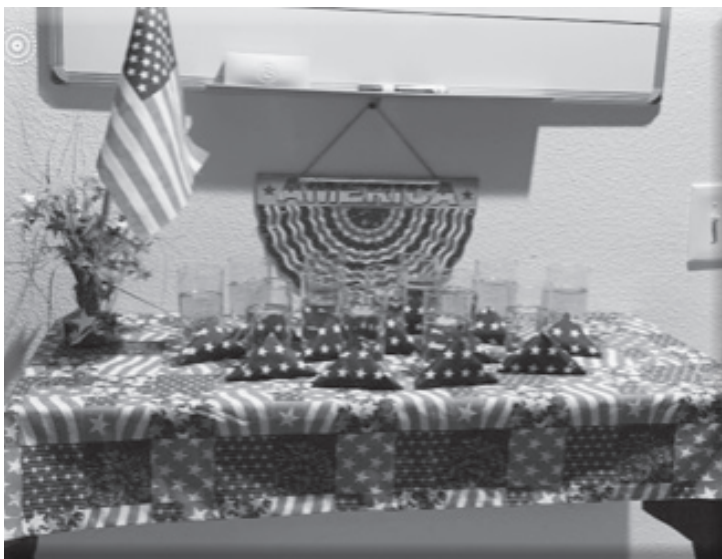
TRUSTEE REPORT

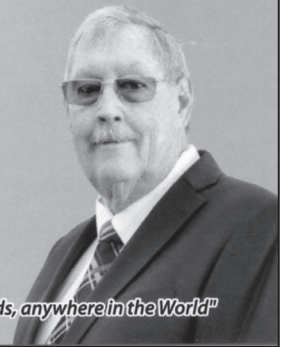
