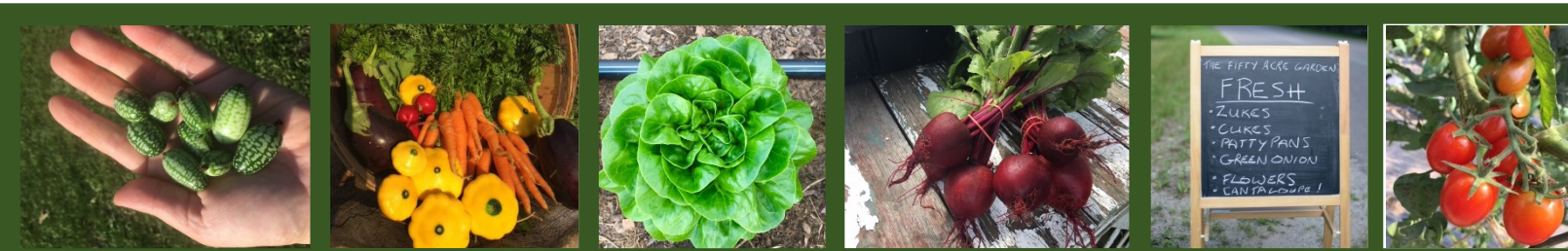

### How it Works:

The Fifty Acre Garden's Freshly Picked subscription will begin Saturday, July 3rd, 2021 and run through and including Wednesday, October 13<sup>th</sup>, 2021.

- Subscribers get the best of our fresh, local vegetables and fruit at a rate discounted from our regular market prices (a 10% discount for Garden Plan subscribers, and 15% for Harvest Plan subscribers).
- The start time for subscription pickups is one hour before our farm-stand opens to the public, allowing subscribers the first choice of produce. Subscribers are also welcome to email [lauren@thefiftyacregarden.com](mailto:lauren@thefiftyacregarden.com) the evening before, and request holds on any produce.
- Subscribers will get 15 pickups.
- At the start of the season, subscribers will be provided with two reusable cloth bags or a bin to bring when picking up their weekly order.
- Subscribers choose their pickup day-of-the-week at the time of registration.
  - If you miss a week, you may double-up your order the next week.

### Payment Details:

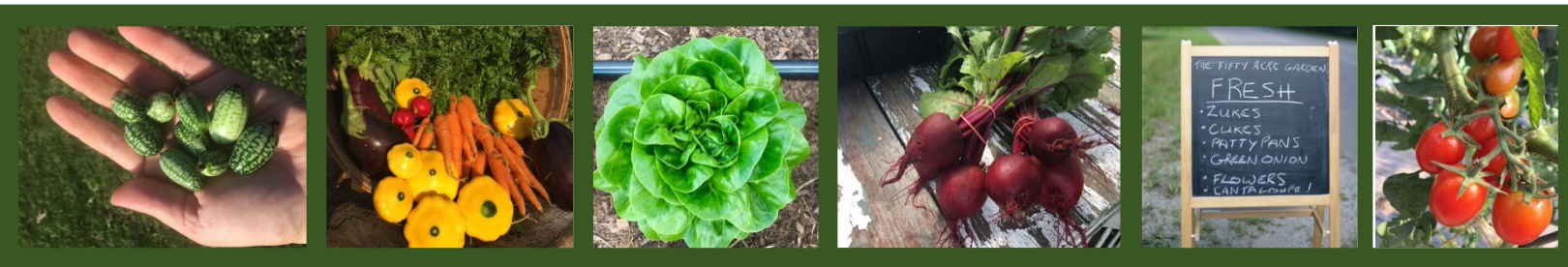
Customers pay upfront at the time of registration. Payment options include (1) cash, (2) e-transfer, or (3) cheque.

- **Cheques** should be made out to "**Robert Cutler**".
- Any NSF fees will be invoiced back to customers.

An early-bird discount of 5% will be applied to the subscription cost for members who register and pay in full before February 1, 2021.

### Important to Know:

- We will continue to take COVID-19 protective measures into our 2021 season.
- We grow without herbicides or pesticides. While we have a variety of pest strategies we employ, there are times when our crops are subject to damage, and we may not be able to



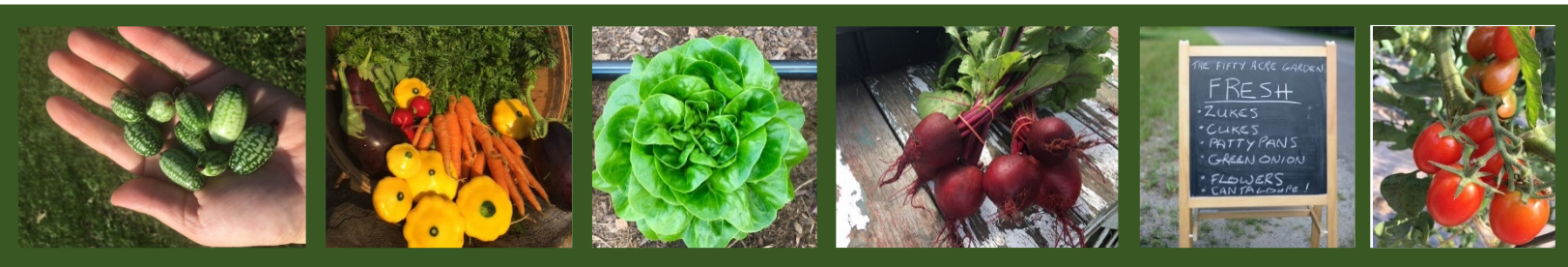
provide the anticipated variety.

- Our production dates are best-estimates and depend on external factors including weather.
- All products should be washed before consuming.
