# ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

*As of January 1, 2022*

## Age Divisions:

West Coast Princess Mini : Ages 5-6  
West Coast Princess Petite : Ages 7-8  
West Coast Princess Pre Teen : Ages 9-10  
West Coast Princess Jr. Teen : Ages 11-12

1st Runner up in each division has the opportunity to go At-Large to Nationals at ½ Price as the State Nickname ie: Beehive State

## WARDROBE REQUIREMENTS

**Opening Number-** Opening number will need a purple cocktail length dress, silver, clear or nude colored shoes.

**Interview Outfit-** You will need a nice dress, skirt suit or jumper. Something that reflects your style and personality.

**Fun Fashion-** Fun Runway style attire to work the runway. Show off your individual personality.

**Evening Gown-** You will need a floor length formal dress, any style, any color. The value of the gown will not be evaluated. Select a dress that makes you feel beautiful!

## Backstage rules and regulations

**One Parent, guardian or coach** is allowed backstage in the dressing area during the pageant.

## **AREAS OF COMPETITION**

### **Personal Interview**

In this segment of the competition, each Delegate is judged individually by four to five judges in round robin format. The Judges will have approximately 3 minutes with each Pre Teen and Jr Teen Delegate and 2 min with Mini and Petite Delegates

#### **Judging Criteria:**

Content of Judges Bio (Pre Teen and Jr Teen), Knowledge, Perception (Pre Teen and Jr Teen), Self-Expression. Spontaneity and Personality will be evaluated. Appearance and Grooming.

Here are some things the Judges will be thinking about:

How well did the Contestant answer the question in terms of content and knowledge?

How quickly was the contestant able to think on her feet?

Is She having Fun?

### **Fun Fashion Competition**

#### **Judging Criteria:**

Confidence, Choice of outfit, Poise, Posture and Execution of Movement will be evaluated. Here are some of the questions the Judges will be thinking about during this segment of the competition:

How well did the contestant model her Outfit of choice?

How well did the contestant's walk the runway?

How well did the contestant convey confidence while having fun?

### **Evening Gown Competition**

#### **Judging Criteria:**

Confidence, Choice of Evening Gown, Poise, Posture, Personality, Charm, Style, Charisma, Grace, Execution, Overall Appearance and Stage Presence will be evaluated. Here are some of the questions the Judges will be thinking about during the Evening Gown Competition.

How well did the contestant model her gown in terms of technique and elegance?

How well did the contestant's use the stage for her gown?

How well did the contestant convey confidence?

### **Onstage Question-**

#### **Judging Criteria:**

Spontaneity, Personality, Voice, Confidence, and Sense of Values will be evaluated. Here are some of the questions the Judges will be considering during the On-Stage Interview Competition:

How well did the contestant answer the question in terms of content ?

How quickly was the contestant able to think on her feet?

**In the event of a tie, the delegate with the higher interview score shall prevail as the winner.**

**\*Judge's decisions are FINAL!**

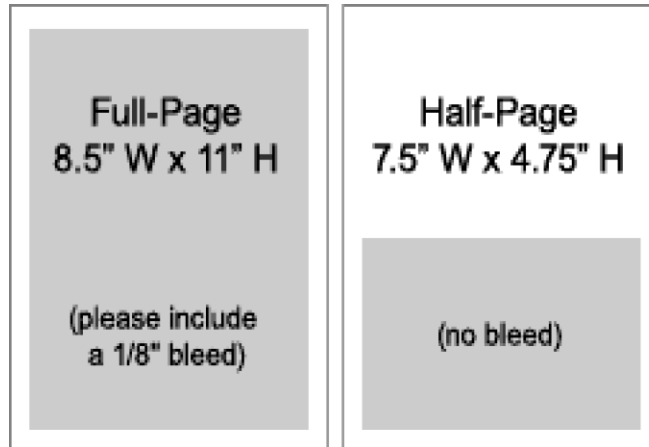

- Headshot, professional photo, NO sash and crowns allowed
- Copy of birth certificate, naturalization, or permanent resident card
- Ad Page artwork/fees/forms (as soon as they are ready, but NO LATER than one month prior to the pageant)
- Any other documents requested by the director.
- Judges Bio Form (Pre Teen and Jr Teen)

## FAQ'S

### **Do I have to compete in and win a preliminary competition in order to compete in the national pageant?**

There may or may not be STATE preliminaries available in your area, if there is not an official pageant in your state, you will apply directly for a National Title.

### **How long does it take to receive my sash and crown?**

Once the sash is ordered it generally takes 3-4 weeks for production.

### **Is there a minimum amount of tickets I am required to sell? NO!**

### **Do I get a free ticket for my parents?**

Yes! One ticket is available for a Parent or Guardian helping backstage. Everyone else must purchase a ticket to attend the pageant.

### **When do tickets go on sale?**

Tickets typically go on sale 2-4 weeks prior to the pageant. You will be notified when they go on sale and given instructions on how to purchase tickets.

### **Do children under 5 need a ticket?**

YES! Everyone needs a ticket.

### **Am I required to use the official Program designer to create my AD PAGE?**

No! But the official Designer is very affordable and does amazing work.

### **Are there any required rehearsals prior to the pageant?**

No. All rehearsals will take place during pageant weekend.

### **How do I sell advertisements in the program book to raise money towards my pageant expenses?**

Once you are registered as a contestant, you will be provided a sponsorship letter to present to businesses, friends and family who may wish to support you by either purchasing an advertisement to simply wish you good luck or to promote and highlight their business!
