Reflections categories include:

<u>Photography</u> ~ print may be 3" X 5" up to 8" X 10" and must be mounted on mat board <u>Music Composition</u> ~ 1 GB in file size and no more than 5 minutes in length <u>Visual Arts 2-D</u> ~ may not exceed 24" X 30", and can't be thick (no stretched canvas) <u>Visual Arts 3-D</u> ~ 3 photos of the 3-D piece (different angles), mounted on mat board <u>Dance Choreography</u> ~ 1 GB in file size and no more than 5 minutes in length <u>Film Production</u> ~ 1 GB in file size and no more than 5 minutes in length

- Students in grades K-5th may participate.
