Enrollment

Enrollment begins March 4, 2022.

Tuition

Service Hours

Each family is required to perform 10 hours per semester for Sacred Heart Catholic School. This service can be achieved at a variety of functions approved by the school principal throughout the school year.

Non-completed hours for the fall semester will be billed on the first Friday in January to the family's FACTS account at \$25/hr. non-completed hours for the spring semester will be billed on the first Friday in June.

Service Hours need to be completed before the last day of school in May of 2023.

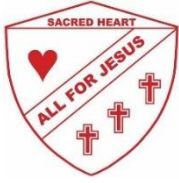

Sacred Heart School relies on each family to help provide our children with the best education. We wish to provide opportunities for teamwork in helping the school foster good relationships between home and school.

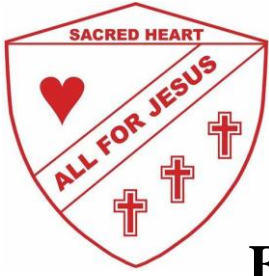
Each family is required to provide 10 service hours per semester, which will total 20 annual service hours. The hours can be served by a parent, grandparent, or a family member that is 18 years or older. Students cannot do service hours for the family. Any and all volunteers must complete Virtus safe environment training and a criminal background check prior to their service.

Service hour forms should be submitted to a member of the PTC council within 30 days of the event or 24 hours after the event. Ten service hours must be completed prior to the end of the 1st semester (December) and ten more no later than the last day of school for the 2nd semester (May). Any family not meeting the time commitment will be invoiced at a rate of \$25 per hour for each hour not completed. **If a parent does not show up for an event that they have signed up for they will automatically be charged a \$25 fee.**

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Extended Care Program Form 2022-2023

Sacred Heart Catholic School offers Extended Care as an extension for the existing school day. Children must be current students at our school and must register in the Extended Care Program. The program operates from 3:45 p.m.-5:15 p.m. on school days **only**. The schedule will include outdoor play time, arts, and crafts, reading, homework, and tutoring time. A snack will be served daily, upon completion of homework time. The EXTENDED CARE PROGRAM will not be available on weekends, holidays, ½ days or during school vacation periods. A child becomes a drop-in at 3:46 p.m. and the student's account will be charged (\$10/day) accordingly.

I, _____, understand that charges for the After School Program are in addition to monthly tuition, and must be paid on the date I have selected through FACTS Tuition. Payment must be paid in full regardless of the number of days attended each month. The Extended Care will be charged and credit through your FACTS account.

Additional charges: There will be an additional charge of \$20.00 for each day a student is not picked up by 5:15 p.m. All families are required to fill out one Extended Care Form per student in the event a parent has taken advantage of this service.

Flat Rate: \$35.00 per child per week

Whether one day or all five days are utilized, \$35 will be charged to student's account per week.
