Our Jurors

John O'Sullivan is the owner of Art and Frame in Newtown. He has been a resident of the greater Danbury area almost his entire life, graduating from Bethel High school in 1988. He studied fine art painting and sculpture at the School of Visual Arts in New York City, focusing on kinetic musical sculptures for his thesis. He graduated in 1993.

His love of art and going to galleries highly influenced his career. He set up Art & Frame to provide a gallery space for local talent. A new show is hung and celebrated every six weeks, and he has proudly shown artists from 5 to 95 years of age.

David Gesualdi is a Sculptor/Printmaker. His work is figurative and reality is used as a spring board to launch a discovery process into a variety of physical materials. David has explored the many possibilities in the materials of marble, bronze and all aspects of intaglio printmaking. His work has been exhibited in museums and galleries throughout the New York metropolitan area, most notably, in New York at The National Academy Museum, Artist Space Gallery, and The Fervor Gallery; and in Connecticut at The Silvermine Guild Gallery , Still River Editions and The Center for Contemporary Printmaking. Commissioned public monuments include the Bethel Veterans Monument, which now stands in front of the Bethel, CT Municipal Center. The P.T. Barnum Monument (a life size full figure portrait statue in bronze) which now stands in front of the Bethel, CT Public Library. Richard

Reynolds Memorial (a life size full figure portrait statue in bronze) in Montgomery, NY.
