GOLDEN TRIANGLE WITH RANTHAMBORE

VISIT CITIES: DELHI + AGRA + RANTHAMBORE + JAIPUR

DAY 1 ARRIVE DELHI

Meet and greet assistance on arrival at Delhi Railway Station / Airport, transfer to Hotel. On arrival check-in to hotel. In afternoon visit Akshardham & Lotus Temple. Over Night stay at Delhi Hotel. (NOTE: Delhi's Major Point closed on Mo nday)

Delhi: The Capital of India, Delhi is diversity with the Indian Culture – The Mughal Architecture, Historical – Modern Monuments places, Museum – Temples. Delhi is a mystical destination of every traveler's dream}. Overnight at Delhi.

DAY 2 DELHI (B)

This morning after breakfast, proceed for a full-day tour of Old and New Delhi. This fascinating city has been in existence since the 6th century BC and has seen ups and downs from the rule of the Pandavas right up to the British Raj. Visit Jama Masjid, which is the largest mosque in India, commissioned by Emperor Shah Jahan. The courtyard of the mosque can hold about 25,000 worshippers. Enjoy a rickshaw ride in Chandni Chowk, the busiest market in Old Delhi...noisy, chaotic and uniquely Indian. You will then drive past from the Red Fort, which was constructed during the rule of Emperor Shah Jahan and served as the residence for the Mughal royal family. It continues to be significant till date, as every Independence Day, the Prime Minister makes a speech from its ramparts as the Indian flag is hoisted. Later, drive past President House and several other government buildings in Edwin Lutyen's Delhi before you head toward Rajghat, the memorial to Mahatma Gandhi. This simple memorial marks the spot where Mahatma Gandhi was cremated in 1948. Thereafter, visit Humayun's Tomb, commissioned by Humayun's wife Hamida Banu Begum in 1562. It was the first garden tomb built in the Indian sub-continent where the Persian architect used red sandstone on a large scale. Later in the evening visit the Qutab Minar, which is the tallest brick minaret in the world; it was commissioned by Qutbuddin Aibak, the first Muslim ruler of Delhi.

DAY 3 DELHI - AGRA (3.5HRS)

After Breakfast drive to another historical and romantic city - Agra. After Noon arrive Agra, visit Taj Mahal {Taj Mahal, is a symbol of devotion and dedication of love & built with Ivory –White Marble with the magnificence of Mughal Architecture} & Red Fort ({Agra Fort was built by Emperor Akbar, completed in 1571. Built with Red Sand Stone is mixture of the Islamic and Hindu style of architecture.} evening free for shopping at local market. (NOTE: Taj Mahal closed on Friday)

{Agra is home to one of the 7 Wonders of the world "TAJ MAHAL". Other major site Red Fort & Fatehpur sikri, which are part of UNESCO World heritage sites. It's located on the bank of river Yamuna. It's an amazing tourist destination with Mugal Rules History – Architecture – Palace – Romance}

Overnight at Agra.



DAY 4 AGRA - RANTHOMBORE (5 HRS)

After breakfast you will leave to Ranthambore. On the way, you will visit Abhaneri and Fatehpur Sikri. Abhaneri – Abhaneri is a village in the Dausa district of Rajasthan state in India. The place is popular for the Chand Baori step well and Harshat Mata Temple.

Fatehpur Sikri- It is believed to be one of the first carefully planned cities of the Mughals. It was built by Emperor Akbar in the 16th century AD. Its name basically means the 'City of Victory.'

Arrive Ranthambore and check-in to your hotel. Overnight in Ranthambore Overnight in Ranthambore.

DAY 5 RANTHOMBORE

Today experience early morning and evening game drive in the Ranthambore National Park. Ranthambor Tiger Reserve lies on the junction of Aravali and Vindhyas. It sprawls over a varying and undulating landscape. The scenery changes dramatically from gentle and steep slopes of the Vindhyas to the sharp and conical hills of the Aravali. The tiger is not the only attraction at Ranthambore. A variety of birds including owlets, the ubiquitous langur (monkey), leopard, caracal, hyena, jackal, jungle cat, marsh crocodiles, wild boar, bears and various species of deer are the other attractions. Overnight in Ranthambor

DAY 6 RANTHOMBORE - JAIPUR (3hrs)

(B)

After breakfast, drive to Jaipur - the gateway to the magnificent and vibrant state of Rajasthan. Arrive Jaipur and check-in to your hotel. Evening free for Leisure or Jaipur offers various options from Fabric to Gems for shopaholic.

Overnight in Jaipur.

DAY 7 JAIPUR (B)

Proceed for full-day sightseeing trip of Jaipur, also known as the 'Pink City'. The city of Jaipur is capital to the state of Rajasthan, famous for its colorful culture, forts, palaces, and lakes. Jaipur owes its name to the founder of the city, warrior king Sawai Jai Singh II. Visit the Amber Fort. The best way to explore the fort is to ride up to it on Elephant back. Prominent structures inside the fort are the Diwan-i-Aam, adorned with latticed galleries, the Ganesh Pol, with a beautiful painted image of Lord Ganesh, and the stunning Sheesh Mahal, a hall decorated with thousands of tiny mirrors. Later, stop to photograph the beautiful Hawa Mahal, also known as the "Palace of the Winds." This beautiful façade with its ornately carved latticework windows was designed so the ladies of the palace could look out onto the streets unobserved. Later you will visit the City Palace... again, a synthesis of Rajasthani and Mughal styles. The museums here showcase rare and ancient manuscripts, arms dating back to the 15th century, and costumes of erstwhile royalty. Later, visit the Jantar Mantar Observatory, comprising geometric devices for measuring time, and tracking stars in their orbits.

Overnight in Jaipur.

After breakfast check out from hotel and later transfer to Jaipur Railway Station / Airport for your onward journey

HILLS & WILD LIFE OF UTTARAKHAND

VISIT CITIES: NAINITAL + CORBETT + MUSOORIE

DAY 1 ARRIVE DELHI - NAINITAL (6.5HRS)

On arrival at Delhi, you will be met, assisted and drive to Nainital - This was a popular summer vacation resort for the British. In 1817, the commissioner of Kumaon, G.W. Trail was the first European to visit the place. However, he did not mention about the place among his folks in order to retain the religious sanctity of the place. On arrival at Nainital, check in at the hotel. Rest of the day free for individual activities. Overnight stay in Nainital.

DAY 2 NAINITAL (B,D)

Today post breakfast, proceed for local visits. Naina Devi Temple & Hanuman Garhi. Evening enjoy boat ride at Naini lake. Evening visit the local market at the Mall road where one can shop for different types of candles.

DAY 3 NAINITAL - CORBETT (4HRS)

(B,L,D)

Today post breakfast, check out and drive to Corbett– formerly Hailey National Park, is the oldest national park in India which came into existence in 1936, lies on the foothills of Himalayas, to protect the endangered species of Royal Bengal Tiger. Corbett is a home to densest tiger population in the world which guarantees the glimpses of the elusive big cat in its premises. It is a vast Eco-Sphere that is blessed with the plethora of wildlife where you can enjoy several activities like jungle safaris, trekking, bird watching, elephants ride and much more. On arrival at Corbett, check in at the hotel. Rest of the free for individual activities. Overnight stay in Corbett.

DAY 4 CORBETT (B,L,D)

Today early morning and afternoon game drive to the national park. Other residents of the park include four kinds of Deer, Wild Boar and some lesser-known animals. Leopards are mostly found in the hilly areas of the Corbett Park. Some nocturnal cats found here are the Leopard Cat, Jungle Cat and Fishing Cat. Sloth Bear is found in the lower regions of the park while the Himalayan Black Bear is seen in the higher hills only. The Dole or Wild Dog, though they can be seen in the southern areas of the park along with the Jackal. Some of the smaller residents of the park are Himalayan Palm Civet, Indian Gray Mongoose, Common Otter, Black Naped Hare and Porcupine. Elephants are among one of the main attractions of Jim Corbett Park. Rest of the day free for individual activities.

DAY 5 CORBETT - MUSOORIE (5 HRS)

Today post breakfast, check out and drive to Mussoorie - established by the British in 1823, Mussoorie became hugely popular with the Raj set. The influence of that era linger on in the architecture of the churches, libraries, hotels and summer palaces, also on adjacent town Landour. On arrival at Mussoorie, check-in at hotel. Evening, stroll down on Mall road – structure of the road will take you back to the colonial period of British. Along with restaurants, hotels and shops, there is a 100 year old Methodist church too. Overnight stay in Mussoorie

DAY 6 MUSOORIE (B,D)

Today post breakfast, proceed for full day sightseeing tour starting with Kempty Falls, Gigantic Fall with somersault of the streams before hitting the bottom, Kempty Falls is the most popular and one of the oldest tourist spot near Mussoorie. Later visit Gun Hill, which is the 2nd highest peak of Mussoorie and can be reached by ropeway too. It offers beautiful panoramic view of snow-capped Himalayan ranges and Doon valley. Also, visit the park estate of Sir George Everest - Mt. Everest was named after him. The place provides excellent view of surrounding valleys and peaks. Evening spend some time at Landour. Overnight stay in Mussoorie

DAY 7 DEPART MUSOORIE – DEHRADUN (1.5 HRS)/ DELHI (6 HRS)
