#### WHERE IS UKRAINE?

Dead center between NATO countries and Russia!

• 44 million people on 233,000 sq miles

- 800 miles wide, facing West into the weak center of NATO
- facing East into the "soft underbelly" of Russia.
- Either a "buffer" or an attack route!

#### WHAT IS ITS HISTORY?

• Consolidated into the Russian Empire in 18th Century,

• Founding member of Soviet Union in 1922

• Independent after 1991 ...

• "partner" with NATO in 1994 and member of the EU

#### WHY IS IT IMPORTANT TO PUTIN?

- Ukraine threw out his stooge in 2014 and became democratic and capitalist
- "Dangerous **example f**or Russian states!"
  - Potential member of NATO and EU.
- Russian goal of 2015 "Minsk Accords" was to subvert Kyiv government by reattaching two separatist territories with veto power, but Kyiv demurred

## February 19<sup>th</sup>

Munich Security Conference:

- President Zelenskyy meets Vice President Harris and asks to meet with Putin
- Zelenskyy: "Security of our world is brittle and obsolete."
- Harris: "Russia will see economic measures that will be swift and severe!"

• 150,000 Russian troops collect outside Ukrainian border!

## February 19th

 Pro-Russian Ukrainian declares "immediate threat from aggressor Ukraine" and evacuates civilians to Russia

President Biden "convinced that Putin has decided to invade Ukraine"

• Putin conducts nuclear weapons drills and fleet exercises in Black Sea

#### February 21st

• Putin's speech: "Ukraine is historical accident. US developing Ukraine into theater of military operations."

• Putin recognizes two separatist regions as "independent" and deploys troops to occupy them, claiming that Ukraine was about to attack,

• US prohibits investments, etc. in the regions and evacuates US diplomats from Ukraine.

#### February 21st

- Kyiv requests urgent UN Security Council meeting
- EU declares Putin's action "blatant violation of international law" [Violation of Ukrainian sovereignty (UN Charter)]
- French president visits Putin (first of several western leaders) describes him as "talking in circles, rewriting history rigid, isolated, in an ideological and security-minded drift."

## February 24th

• Russia attacks!

• Putin acts "to protect people subject to abuse, genocide by Kyiv .... to demilitarize and de-nazify Ukraine"

Kyiv declares state of emergency and mobilizes reserves

• Russia moves forces from border with China and deploys forces into Belorussia on Ukraine's northern border

#### PUTIN DOES NOT HAVE "STALIN'S ARMY"

Russian soldiers realize they are not fighting Nazi invaders

Russian logistic support collapses

## February 24th

The attack stalls!

• Russians cremate their dead – no body bags return to Russia

Russians resort to bombing civilians & destroying towns and villages



#### Military comparison Ukraine Russia

Since the invasion, Ukraine has received military aid from many countries, including the vast majority of NATO member states. It has received antitank and antiaircraft weaponry from countries including the U.S.





#### Main battle tanks

#### Ukraine 987 Russia At least 3,417

Armored and tracked vehicles, armed with a turret-mounted gun of at least 100mm caliber and with a combat weight of between 35 and 75 metric tonnes.

## REACTION

- Ukrainian army and civilian morale surprisingly strong
- Constant flow of modern weapons into Ukraine
- 141 nations at UN condemn Putin's attack
- US, UK and EU establish united front (almost) in imposing sanctions

# REACTION

- Russian exports denied almost everywhere (Germany and China excepted)
- Foreign-based companies close business in Russia
  - McDonalds, Starbucks, etc.
- Russian banking system isolated from almost all banks and financial markets

# AND MORE THAN 2 MILLION UKRANIANS FLEE AS REFUGEES

## AFTERMATH

• Ukraine lost to Russia (impossible to occupy even if defeated)

Consolidation of a militarily powerful NATO

• Disruption of World Economy (Ukraine was #1 – or #2 or #3 – in food and ore exports, and Russia was #3 or #4 in fossile fuel exports)

## AFTERMATH

Reparations, restitution and rebuilding of Ukraine – who will pay?

• Millions of displaced Ukrainians – where will they resettle?

• War crimes trials
