Classes are offered in 12-week sessions, one evening per week.

## Sessions include

Employment skills such as:

- ◆ Locating/applying for jobs
- ◆ Resume writing
- ◆ Interview skills
- ◆ Workplace behavior

Life skills such as:

- ◆ Wise decision making
- ◆ Setting SMART goals
- ◆ Communication skills
- ◆ Self-care
- ◆ Financial skills and resources
- ◆ Educational resources
- ◆ Healthcare resources

Biblical skills such as:

- ◆ Recognizing God's promise for your life
- ◆ Recognizing God's purpose for your life

Participants are paired with mentors for encouragement accountability,
