Saskatchewan Provincial Good Sam SAMGO

Procedures

- 1. Remove the float before calculating payouts.
 - a. Put the float aside for the next day
 - b. Float to be returned to the Provincial Treasurer after the final SAMGO session.
- 2. Add up the total sales and deduct 10%.
 - a. The 10% is required to offset supply costs.
- 3. Divide the balance of the money by 12.
- 4. Payouts are as follows:
 - a. Games 1, 2, 3, 4, 6, 7, 8 and $9 1/12^{\text{th}}$ of the money.
 - b. Game $5 2/12^{\text{th}}$ of the money
 - c. Game $10 2/12^{\text{th}}$ of the money plus the balance of money collected for single game sheets.
- 5. Proceeds of money collected from Dabber sales go to the Provincial Treasurer and is NOT included with prize winnings.
- 6. Prices:
 - a. Dabbers \$1.25 each
 - b. Bingo Cards
 - i. Book of 10 games \$5.00
 - ii. Individual cards \$0.25 (only used in games 5 & 10)
 - c. Books must be purchased before individual sheets can be purchased.
- 7. Supplies for SAMGO (enough for both rallies)
 - a. Banded 10 packs -8 (each pack holds 50 ten packs)
 - b. Singles enough to make up 1000 cards
 - c. Dabbers 24
 - d. Notes:
 - i. When purchasing Bingo paper, you have to buy a full case.
 - ii. The Saskatoon supplier cuts the Bingo paper into 3 up game cards and singles.
 - iii. The above amounts for Bingo paper and dabbers should be enough for both the big Rally and the Mini Rally.
