2017 PROGRESS UPDATE

September 2017

Here is what your neighborhood association has been doing so far in 2017.

Continued contact with Councilman Keen and Parish: CENA hosted a meet and greet with Councilman Keen earlier in the year on behalf of the neighborhood residents and continues to correspond with Mr. Keen about road work, drainage, and the sewer project. CENA periodically attends Livingston Parish Council Meetings on behalf of the neighborhood. Neighborhood roads have been added to the Priority Lists for repaving and it is anticipated the roads will be repaved sometime in 2018. In the meantime, road patches have been done. CENA continues to receive updates from the sewer district on the sewer expansion project. The latest report showed the estimated completion date being August 30, 2017. CENA also continues contact with Gravity Drainage as needed in regards to drainage and ditches.

Entrance Improvements: In the Spring, CENA hired a contractor to pressure wash the front of the brick walls to remove mold and mildew. Holiday decorations were provided for 4th of July. Efforts to improve the health of the Crepe Myrtle trees at the entrance are being sought by administering fertilizer.


Safety and Security: CENA continues to report street lights out to DEMCO as needed. Children at Play signs have been installed at various locations throughout the neighborhood. CENA has been in contact with LPSO in regards to issues with speeding on neighborhood streets and were advised that a request would be sent for additional patrol. CENA has been researching options for security cameras at the front entrance and anticipates to have a camera installed by year's end. Plans are underway for fundraising to help in the costs of the security camera project. Servitude access from behind our neighborhood has been restricted. The bridge over the creek adjacent to the pond was removed by the parish. CENA will be installing a No Soliciting/No Loitering sign at the entrance. Once again, CENA plans to have LPSO patrol the neighborhood on Halloween during Trick or Treat hours.

Community Garage Sale: CENA sponsored a community garage sale earlier in the year.
