Here are a few of our accomplishments:

- Hosted a Meet and Greet with Councilman Scooter Keen in 2017. Neighborhood concerns were discussed, and Scooter provided parish updates of ongoing projects in and around Denham Springs.
- The front of the brick wall at the entrance of the subdivision was pressure washed to remove years of mildew build up. This instantly increased the curb appeal at the entrance.
- In 2017 neighborhood roads were patched, added to the priority list to be repaved, and approved by the parish council to be repaved in 2018. All roads in the neighborhood were repaved in 2018.
- Drainage issues were addressed in 2018 which coincided with the repaving of our roads
- Parish blocked servitude access by the pond in the back of the neighborhood for added security
- Sewer has been connected to the parish system
- Speed limit reduced from 25 to 20 miles per hour
- No Soliciting sign placed at entrance
- Neighborhood newsletter created and mailed twice per year or as needed
- Parish installed Children at Play signs throughout the neighborhood
- Report burned out street lights to Demco for replacement
- Street light poles were painted by Demco at CENA's request.
- Security detail hired on Halloween during trick or treat hours.
- Installation of a three-way stop at Creek Haven/Creek Bend and Creek Valley/Creek Bend.
- Creation of neighborhood website and neighborhood association Facebook page
- Provide holiday decorations at the entrance of the neighborhood
- Mailbox Project initiated in 2018 to assist residents with the painting of their mailbox
- Host CENA member events (crawfish boil, Christmas dinner)
- Host neighborhood events (pictures with Santa, Spring garage sale, North Park meet and greet, Councilman Meet and Greet)
- Treat and care for Crepe Myrtles at the entrance
