New Three-Way Stops

After trying different methods to alleviate the speeding issues on Creek Haven and Creek Valley, CENA discussed the installation of two three way stops being installed. This item for discussion was brought up during the November and January CENA meetings. It was agreed to ask the Livingston Parish Council to include this item on their January meeting agenda. At that time the council approved the addition of the three way stops for our neighborhood. CENA followed-up with the council on March 25th so that it could notify the residents of Creekside Estates via this newsletter of the status. However, we have such a great rapport with our councilman, the stops were installed in a matter of hours which did not allow time for us to alert the neighborhood as a courtesy.

A few voiced concerns about these stops being added. Please know that CENA makes attempts to keep the neighborhood apprised of changes. CENA does post upcoming events, including meetings, on our website Events page and CENA members are notified on the CENA Facebook group. In addition, Livingston Parish Council meetings, agendas and minutes are included on their website which is available for the public to view.

The Mission of CENA is noted on the right side of this page. CENA is comprised of a group of Creekside Estates residents who have joined together with a common identity to better our community and promote it's general welfare. The addition of these two stops provides an additional safety measure for our residents. Without having sidewalks, the residents have no choice but to use the street whether it's walking their dog or jogging for exercise.

CENA is in the process of replacing the silver metal poles with the ornamental poles to match the other signs. We thank our members for their support as it's their donations that make these things possible.



It's important that the local fire department is able to locate a water supply in the event of fire. To ensure this, CENA is in the process of getting the neighborhood Fire Hydrants correctly marked with the installation of blue reflective pavement markers.
