- 3. Make it worthwhile to keep showing up




#### Chat4Change

- A peer driven, naturalistic intervention where young Black and Latinx MSM (YBLMSM) discuss PrEP with their peers on apps like Jack'd, Grindr, and Scruff with the goals of changing perceptions of PrEP uptake and inspiring community members to start PrEP. Chat4Change is a CDC Demonstration Project.
- APNH collaborated with CIRA at Yale, CHER Solutions, and bMindful Web.

Spring 2021: First cohort of PAs trained, and Intervention launched



## Direct messaging on Grindr and Jack'd


- Hire staff who know the ins and outs of GSNs.

- Be legit, be sincere. Practice cultural humility.
- Connect to social media accounts for legitimacy.


