McCall Public Library ~ the anchor for the heart, mind, and spirit of our community...

Since 1972, McCall Public Library has faithfully provided an inclusive space to gather for life long learning, literacy, and a sense of connection. From preschool kids to seniors to remote workers and job seekers, patrons gather here to learn, read, and satisfy their curiosity. For nearly 50 years, the McCall Public Library has been the anchor for the heart, mind, and spirit of our community.

- The Library lends **more books and materials** every year. In 2019, patrons checked out an astonishing 55,622 items!
- The Library's **robust programs**, from Travelogues, Story Hour, Doing Democracy and more, are attended by community members at more than twice the state average.
- The Library serves as **free meeting space** for local volunteer goups, non-profits, and community collaborators who work to better our community.
- The Library is a key factor in **developing a strong workforce.** with critical resources for job seekers and career development.

The desire for services has pushed our 50 year-old facility to its breaking point!

During almost 50 years of McCall Public Library service, McCall's population has nearly doubled and use of the libary has expanded well beyond capacity. In the last 13 years, circulation has increased by 82% and program attendance by an astounding 567%! Meanwhile, the library building has not changed. It is bursting at the seams!

McCall Public Library is now severely hampered by overcrowding with inadequate space for materials, classes, and programs. Just a few examples:

- **Kids are turned away** for programs.
- Adult activities **fill beyond capacity** resulting in uncomfortable and unsafe conditions.
- Quiet study spaces and classroms are non-existent.
- Local groups are turned away due to lack of meeting rooms.
- **Packed shelves** prevent growth of collections and reduce ease of access for patrons.

The time has come to expand, update and modernize the McCall Public Library

How did we arrive at The Next Chapter Campaign for Library Expansion?

In 2018, a Conceptual Design Study by award winning library design firm Ratio drew input from staff, community members, civic leaders, schools, and non-profits. Citizens ages 10 to 90 shared ideas for a library that would not only **serve** our community, but **inspire** it.

The study recommended the library be increased from its current 4,000 square feet to between 12,000 and 15,000 square feet.

In 2019 and 2020 The McCall Library Foundation raised \$1 million in pledges and gifts toward the new library, and the City of McCall put forward a bond in June of 2020 to complete funding for the project.

Although the bond saw a substantial **64% YES vote,** Idaho requires 67% for a bond to pass. Due to the clear and demonstrable support in the community, the City Council went to work refining the bond based on voter feedback. A new, reduced price bond will likely be presented to voters May 18, 2021.

In the meantime, we are continuing to raise funds to provide McCall with a **21st century library. Will you join us?**

Exciting elements the new space will include!

- A large **Children's Library** with designated story time space
- Large, flexible community hall for events and lectures
- Private study rooms and space for remote workers
- Fully integrated work and conferencing technologies
- FabLab/Makerspace for workshops, designing, and creating,
- Comfortable adult reading lounge
- A quiet, separate **teen space** for reading and homework.
- Ample display space for books and exhibitions
- A design that highlights our natural surroundings and includes views of Brundage Mountain and Payette Lake
- Improved staff work space
- Improved parking and pedestrian safety



McCall Public Library Responds to COVID19

In response to the COVID19 pandemic, McCall Public Library has strategically pivoted its services in order to meet our community's needs. The staff's passion for their mission inspired them to elect to return to work in mid-April, reopen our library and provide crucial services and programs in safe, healthy, innovative ways.

- Curbside check out service. Patrons reserve books by phone or online and pick them up out front.
- **Increase in WIFI** so it works well outside and is available 24/7.
- After school programs offered for families struggling with childcare while working.
- Community Cares Information Center.

 McCall librarians connect volunteers with requests for help, in partnership with the Valley County Emergency Operations Center and Central District Health.
- Technology lent to patrons including laptops and video conferencing cameras.

- Outdoor, socially distanced **Story Time** to inspire young children and their families.
- Videos for young children are regularly posted on the library YouTube channel.
- Programs like award winning Doing Democracy and popular Tech Tuesday continue on Zoom.
- The popular Let's Talk About was shut down by COVID19 but the library created Let's Walk About It and migrated outdoors. It's a book club led by local scholars!
- The Idaho Room is reservable for study partners, students, remote workers.

HIGHLIGHT! The TutorMobile, a cooperative effort between McCall Pubic Library, Shepherd's Home, and McCall Parks and Rec, visits neighborhoods to offer homework help to prevent kids falling through the cracks on days they are not in school.
