What It Does

- Legalizes Cannabis for All Adults: Repeals all existing cannabis laws, allowing adults 21+ to possess, grow, and use cannabis in all forms—flower, edibles, concentrates—with no THC caps.
- Empowers Citizens: Grants every Georgian the right to grow.
- Creates Jobs and Revenue: Establishes a licensed cannabis industry, prioritizing local businesses and communities harmed by past laws.

Why It Matters

- Beats the Illicit Market: Legal home growing meets personal demand without feeding unlicensed sales.
- **Economic Boost**: Taxes cannabis like alcohol (5% flower, 7% edibles, 10% concentrates), funding:
 - 38% Education
 - 29% Restorative Justice
 - 19% Public Health
 - 9% Rural Development
 - 5% Industry Sustainability innovation
- Restores Justice: Automatically expunges non-violent cannabis convictions within 12 months, reinvesting in affected communities.
- Sustainable Future: Recognizes cannabis as a renewable resource, with tax incentives for ecofriendly cultivation.

Key Features

- Possession: Up to 2 oz in public, unlimited at home.
- Safety: Mandatory full panel testing.
- Freedom: No discrimination in jobs, housing, or custody for legal use.
- Oversight: Georgia Cannabis Authority (GCA) ensures fair licensing and tax alignment with alcohol rates.
