



This Is No 'Safe Republican' Seat — TX-24 Is About to Shock the Country

Despite what the election prediction websites are saying — the “Solid Republican” and “Safe R” labels, the lazy assumptions, and the outdated data — let me tell you something from the ground: there is no world in which this is a “safe” Republican race.

I've personally met with thousands of people in my district — homeowners, business owners, teachers, veterans, parents, young professionals — and I can tell you firsthand that the mood here has shifted. There's a strong swing away from the right in North Texas, and it's happening fast.

Beth Van Duyne's favorability is tanking. If anyone actually did polling on her right now, it would be atrocious. She's fully aligned with the MAGA movement and Donald Trump, parroting every word instead of showing a shred of independent thought. She comes across as disconnected, elitist, and uninterested in the people she's supposed to represent.

And here's the kicker — she doesn't even have a primary challenger. That's not strength; that's stagnation.

Meanwhile, I'm out there every single day, building a real movement. My team is large and growing, and I've built organizations before. I know how to create momentum, connect people, and build coalitions. I'm working with talented folks across North Texas, collaborating on new websites, expanding our outreach, and bringing together a coalition of people who want the same thing — real representation, real accountability, and real leadership for the middle majority.

The Economic Reality People Feel Every Day

Our district isn't buying what Trump and Van Duyne are selling anymore. The economy is hurting, and people feel it.

Manufacturing — a backbone of North Texas — is reeling from the Trump tariffs. Over 3.6 million Americans work in manufacturing, and nearly every company I've talked to has been disrupted. Tariffs have driven up costs, slowed imports, and pushed inflation through the roof. Families and businesses are paying the price.

I've met people in Southlake, Grapevine, and Bedford who voted for Trump before — but they're telling me now, “This isn't what we signed up for.” They believed he'd go after violent criminals, not hardworking people trying to make an honest living.

They didn't vote for this level of chaos, cruelty, and constant division. They didn't vote to lose their employees, their

busboys, or their supply chains.

And they sure didn't vote for empty promises about "releasing the Epstein files" while the same voices — Kash Patel, Dan Bongino, and others — continue to feed outrage without delivering truth. Many of their once-loyal followers are disillusioned and walking away from the entire MAGA movement..

What's Coming

North Texas is a battleground — economically, culturally, and politically. The people here are smart, pragmatic, and ready for something new. The middle is growing and it's tired of the noise.

They want lower costs, more stability, safer communities, and policies that actually work. They want honesty, independence, and leadership that doesn't bow to party extremists.

That's what I stand for.

So while the pundits and pollsters sit behind screens labeling this race as "R + 7," we're already building the strongest Democratic machine ever as assembled in Texas. We are hustling 7 days a week, knocking on doors, shaking hands, and meeting the voters they're ignoring. Because when the people are heard — when their real struggles and hopes are represented — this district will flip.

The political pendulum swinging from one extreme to the other is destroying our American institutions. Texans have a new appetite for something in the middle. They're turned off by both the extreme right and the extreme left. In recent TX – 24 races, the only choices in the general election were far right and far left. Beth has never had to run against a moderate like me. A veteran, entrepreneur, and constitutionalist, someone with tons of supporters who identify as Republican. I even count some of last year's Republican precinct chairs amongst my base of enthusiastic supporters.
