Class Descriptions

Number Navigators I (3rd–5th Grade Math)

Students will explore multiplication, division, fractions, geometry, and more as they navigate through challenging problems and real-world applications. This course blends fun activities and projects, group problem-solving, and interactive lessons to strengthen math fluency and critical thinking. This class encourages collaboration, builds resilience, and helps every student see themselves as a capable and confident mathematician.

Crack the Code: Reading Comprehension Strategies (6th-8th grade)

This engaging and skill-building course is designed to help students in grades 6–8 strengthen their reading comprehension abilities, improve comprehension, reading stamina, and confidence across fiction and nonfiction texts. Through a variety of texts, students will practice identifying main ideas, making inferences, analyzing characters, understanding vocabulary in context, and citing evidence to support their answers. Each week will focus on a specific strategy, such as summarizing, comparing texts, or drawing conclusions, with fun group discussions and guided activities to deepen understanding. Students will also build their confidence in test-taking strategies and critical thinking, helping them become more thoughtful and effective readers. This class offers the tools and support to grow as a reader, thinker, and communicator. Skills covered include: Identifying main ideas and supporting details, making inferences and predictions, understanding context clues and vocabulary, analyzing characters, setting, and plot, comparing and contrasting texts, summarizing and drawing conclusions, supporting answers with text evidence, etc.

Literacy Lab (K–2 Language Arts)

This class helps students develop key literacy skills such as phonics, reading comprehension, spelling, handwriting, and writing basics. Through interactive read-aloud stories, phonics games, and creative writing activities, students will build a

strong foundation in reading and writing. Lessons are interactive, hands-on, and designed to nurture a lifelong love for books and storytelling

Visual ASL

Join us for a fun and interactive ASL class where kids will learn the basics of American Sign Language through songs, games, storytelling, and hands on activities. Students will explore new language while building communication and empathy skills.

Group Tutoring

Group tutoring is an engaging and educational time to review some concepts! This course is designed for homeschool students who are needing some assistance with understanding concepts (math, science, social studies or language arts) and would benefit from a small group setting where they can acquire 1:1 support. Our group tutoring sessions are designed to provide support so that students can complete their assignments and strengthen their understanding of challenging concepts with individualized support. Write Right: English Language Arts Writing Breakdown

In this interactive English Language Arts and Writing class, students will strengthen their reading, writing, grammar, and communication skills. Through engaging texts and creative writing prompts, students will learn how to analyze literature, write clearly and effectively, and build strong arguments and narratives. Weekly lessons will include grammar practice, reading comprehension, and writing workshops to help students express themselves with confidence and clarity. Perfect for middle schoolers looking to grow as readers and writers!

ACTING BIZ 101/ Mindset & Learn to Navigate through the Industry

This dynamic acting class goes beyond the stage to prepare students for a real career in the entertainment industry. Students will learn foundational acting techniques while also developing the mindset, confidence, and discipline needed to succeed as a professional actor. From audition prep and on-camera presence to understanding casting calls, agents, and self-promotion, this class offers a practical look at what it takes to break into the business. Perfect for aspiring actors ready to take their passion seriously.

Number Navigators II (6th–7th Grade Math)

This course is designed for middle school students ready to dive deep into advanced math concepts including ratios, algebraic expressions, equations, graphing, percentages, and related geometry topics. Through collaborative projects, puzzles, real-life applications, written drills, and lectures students will strengthen their problem-solving abilities and mathematical reasoning. Little Explorers Science Lab (K-2 Science)

STEMpreneurs Academy of Tech & Engineering

In this course, students explore STEM/STEAM through hands-on projects in coding, robotics, tech design, and engineering. Foreign Language
