Cutting

Background Fabric

- (1) 9 ½"x5 ½" Rectangle
- (1) 5" Square
- (1) 10"x13" Rectangle

Fabric 1 ■

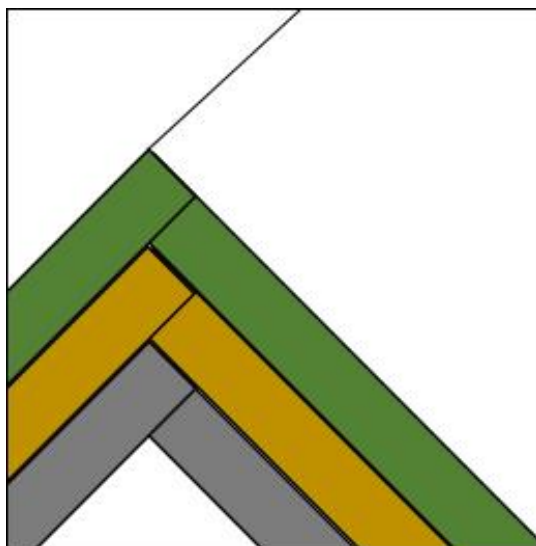
- (2) 6.5"x2" Rectangle

Fabric 2 ■

- (1) 6.5"x2" Rectangle
- (1) 10"x2" Rectangle

Fabric 3 ■

- (1) 6.5"x2" Rectangle
- (1) 13"x2" Rectangle

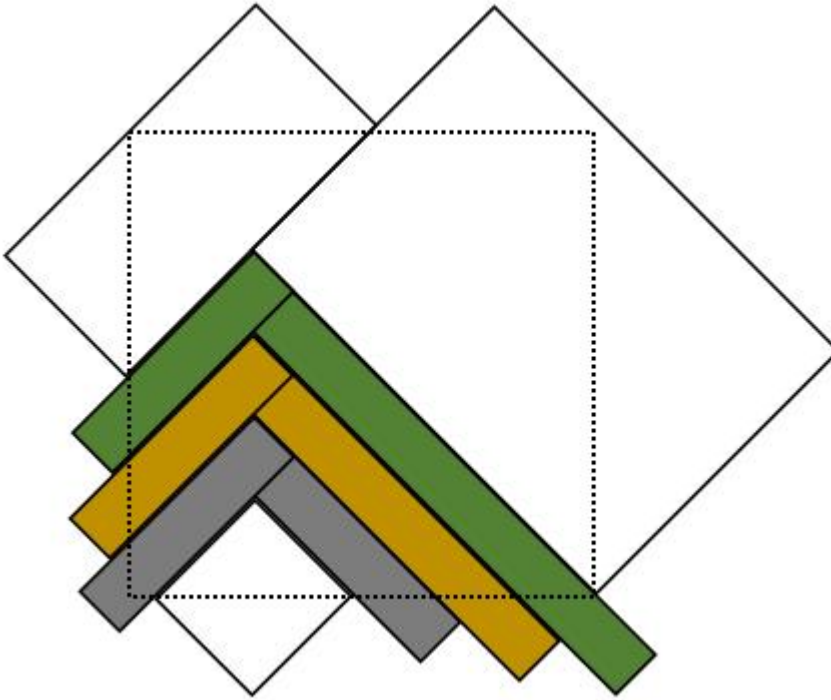


Assembly

1. Sew one of the 6.5"x2" rectangles from Fabric 1 to the right side of the 5" Square of Background Fabric lining up the edges on the top
2. Sew the other 6.5"x2" rectangle from Fabric 1 to the top of the piecing lining up the edges on the right
3. Sew the 10"x2" rectangles from Fabric 2 to the right side of the piecing lining up the edges on the top
4. Sew the 6.5"x2" rectangle from Fabric 2 to the top of the piecing lining up the edges on the right
5. Sew the 13"x2" rectangles from Fabric 3 to the right side of the piecing lining up the edges on the top
6. Sew the 6.5"x2" rectangle from Fabric 3 to the top of the piecing lining up the edges on the right
7. Sew the 10"x13" rectangle Background Fabric to the right side of the piecing lining up the edges on the top
8. Sew the 9½"x5½" Rectangle to the top of the piecing lining up the left side ½" from the left side of Fabric 3 on top

Cut the Final Block out

Rotate your block 45° and cut out your block using either a 12½"x12½" ruler or by drawing cutting lines on your block to create the 12½"x12½" square
