


## October 2018 BOM



3 fabrics - ¼" seam Cut: Background 2 squares 4 7%" 4 rectangles 4 ½" x 2 ½" 4 squares 2 ½" Outer Ring 2 squares 4 7%" 4 rectangles 4 ½" x 2 ½" Center Square 1 square 4 ½"

- 1. Draw a diagonal line through the center of the large background squares
- 2. Place a 4 7/8" background square right side together with Outer Ring square and sew ¼" from each side of the drawn line.
- 3. Cut on the line and press towards the print. You will now have 4 half square triangles.
- 4. Sew a background rectangle to a print rectangle, long edges together, press towards the outer ring print.
- 5. Draw a diagonal line through the center of the remaining 4 background squares
- 6. On each outer ring triangle place a white square right side together in the corner. Sew <u>on the line</u>.
- 7. Fold the triangle you just made to the corner and press. You will have 3 layers of fabric in the corner, if you choose you may cut off the back 2 layers leaving a ¼" seam allowance.
- 8. Lay out the units you just made and sew together.
