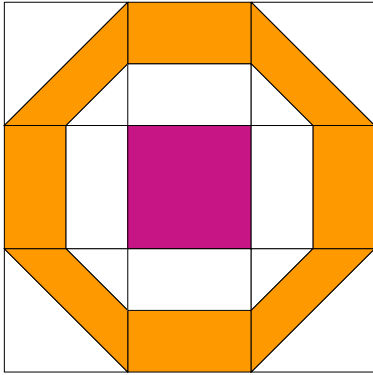

3 fabrics - $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam

Cut:

Background

2 squares $4\frac{7}{8}$ "

4 rectangles $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ "

4 squares $2\frac{1}{2}$ "

Outer Ring

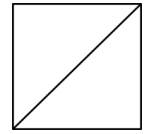
2 squares $4\frac{7}{8}$ "

4 rectangles $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ "

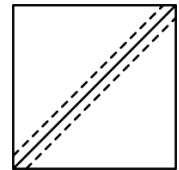
Center Square

1 square $4\frac{1}{2}$ "

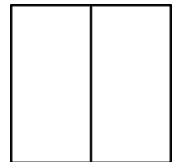
1. Draw a diagonal line through the center of the large background squares



2. Place a $4\frac{7}{8}$ " background square right side together with Outer Ring square and sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " from each side of the drawn line.



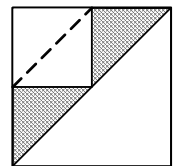
3. Cut on the line and press towards the print. You will now have 4 half square triangles.



4. Sew a background rectangle to a print rectangle, long edges together, press towards the outer ring print.

5. Draw a diagonal line through the center of the remaining 4 background squares

6. On each outer ring triangle place a white square right side together in the corner. Sew on the line.



7. Fold the triangle you just made to the corner and press. You will have 3 layers of fabric in the corner, if you choose you may cut off the back 2 layers leaving a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.

8. Lay out the units you just made and sew together.
