Block of the Month 2026 #2

Make one block

3 fabrics plus background

$\frac{1}{4}$ " seam

Block should measure $12\frac{1}{2}$ " when complete

Cut:

Background

4 squares $2\frac{3}{8}$ "

4 squares 2"

4 squares $3\frac{7}{8}$ "

4 squares $3\frac{1}{2}$ "

Fabric 1

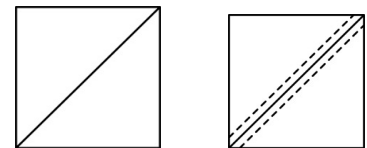
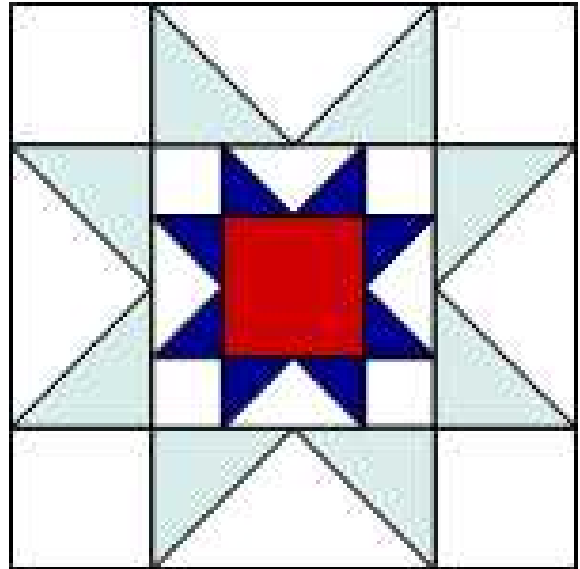
4 squares $2\frac{3}{8}$ "

Fabric 2

4 squares $3\frac{7}{8}$ "

Fabric 3

1 square $3\frac{1}{2}$ "



1. Draw a diagonal line through the center of the background $2\frac{3}{8}$ " squares. Place the background squares right side together with the Fabric 1 squares. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " from each side of the drawn line. Cut on the line and press to one side. You will now have 8 half square triangles
2. Lay out the units as shown above with the Fabric 3 square in the middle and the background 2" squares in the corners
3. Sew the units in each row together.
4. Draw a diagonal line through the center of the background $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares. Place the background squares right side together with the Fabric 2 squares. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " from each side of the drawn line. Cut on the line and press to one side. You will now have 8 half square triangles.
5. Lay out as pictured above
6. Sew the rows together.
