Grab 'n Go Bags FAQ

What are Grab 'n Go Bags?

Grab 'n Go Bags are handmade totes designed for Texas Rainbow Rooms to provide essential items to children in crises. These bags are used for emergency removals by child Protective Services (CPS) and help children who may be leaving their homes unexpectedly with few or no personal belongings.

What are Rainbow Rooms?

Rainbow Rooms are resource centers located in CPS offices throughout Texas, providing immediate access to clothing, diapers, school supplies, hygiene products, and other essentials for children in crisis. There are more than 130 Rainbow Rooms across Texas, and they are available to CPS caseworkers 24/7 to ensure that children and families receive support when they need it most.

What items are included in a Grab 'n Go Bag?

Each Grab 'n Go Bag typically contains a variety of essential items to meet the immediate needs of children being removed from their homes. These may include:

- Clothing (shirts, pants, undergarments, socks)
- Hygiene products (toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, etc.)
- Small comfort items (stuffed animals, blankets)
- Diapers and wipes (for babies and toddlers)
- School supplies (depending on the child's age)

Who makes the Grab 'n Go Bags?

The totes are handmade by volunteers and donors who are passionate about supporting foster care youth and children in crisis. These generous individuals donate their time, skills, and resources to ensure that each bag is thoughtfully made and filled with quality items.

These children range from infants to teenagers and are often taken to safe locations with little time to pack their personal belongings. Why are handmade totes important?

Using handmade totes instead of trash bags or other disposable containers sends a message of dignity and care to the children who receive them. The bags are made with love and respect, ensuring that the children know they are valued during their transition, instead of plastic grocery bags. Plus, the child gets to keep the bag.

Are donations tax-deductible?
