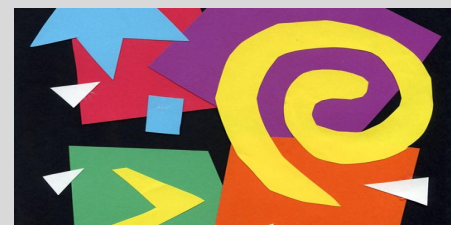

Sampson Arts Council – Summer Art Camps 2021

General Information

Each Art Camp is limited to 8 students per week on a first-come basis. Ages: entering grades 1 - 12 / Fall 2021

Classes are held Monday through Thursday 9:00 am - 12:00 pm (for Morning Classes) or 1:00 - 4:00 pm (for Afternoon Classes), depending on the class you register for.

Students attend (3) hour long classes each day with one art teacher. Students will explore creative lessons in a variety of media including painting, drawing, printmaking, sculpture, etc.

There will be daily health screenings for campers and staff, including temperature checks. Campers and staff will be required to wear masks and will engage in increased hand washing and use of hand sanitizer throughout the day. Campers will be spread out in the studio and practice social distancing.

Registration: Advance/non-refundable registration is required and must be received by **June 15, 2021**
