Students will choose a shape representing their interests from a variety of shaped cookie cutters to create a unique and functional artist's tool not available in stores. Students will learn ceramic techniques of slab rolling, carving, coiling, score, slip, and glazing, to make paint palettes. Then they will use their palette to experiment with watercolor painting techniques.
