GRANT APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS: Calendar Year 2026

The mission of Your Community Foundation is to advance the quality of life in Allen County and surrounding areas by building permanent endowments, fostering philanthropy, energizing community communication, helping donors achieve charitable goals, and leave lasting legacies. www.givingmakesadifference.org.

Who Qualifies:

- Established nonprofit organizations
- Units of local governments (including schools, universities, libraries, arts agencies, etc.)
- Churches applying for community-based projects

Application Instructions:

1. The Foundation may accept multiple applications from the same organization within a year; however, any request for a previously declined or deferred grant will not be accepted in the same calendar year.
2. The Foundation does not require matching funds; however, preference may be given to those organizations that have secured funds from other sources.
3. All application documents listed are required. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
4. If funded, the applicant must submit a final report 30 days after the project's end-date. An organization will not be eligible for future funding until a report is submitted.
5. The Foundation may request additional information or progress reports from any applicant or funded organization if needed.

The following documents must be included with your application:

- a. The completed Grant Application form
- b. A summary of the project income and budget.
- c. A copy of the organization's 501(c)3 designation letter or other proof of exempt status.
- d. A list of your Board of Directors
