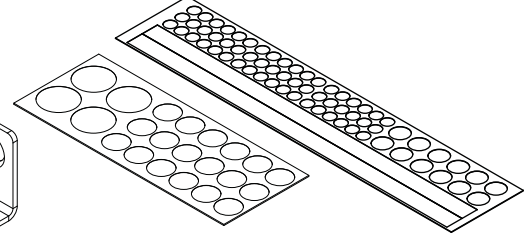

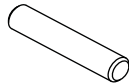

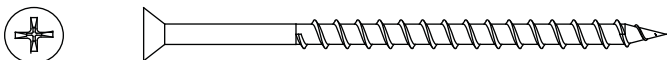

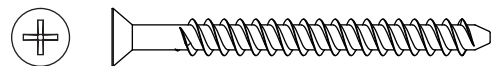

BLACK 1-15/16" FLAT HEAD SCREW (UPRIGHTS to BRACE and SHELVES)



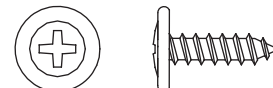
SILVER 3/4" SELF DRILLING (ROD to ROD BRACKET)



SILVER 3/4" FLAT HEAD SCREW (ROD BRACKET to UPRIGHT and CLEATS)



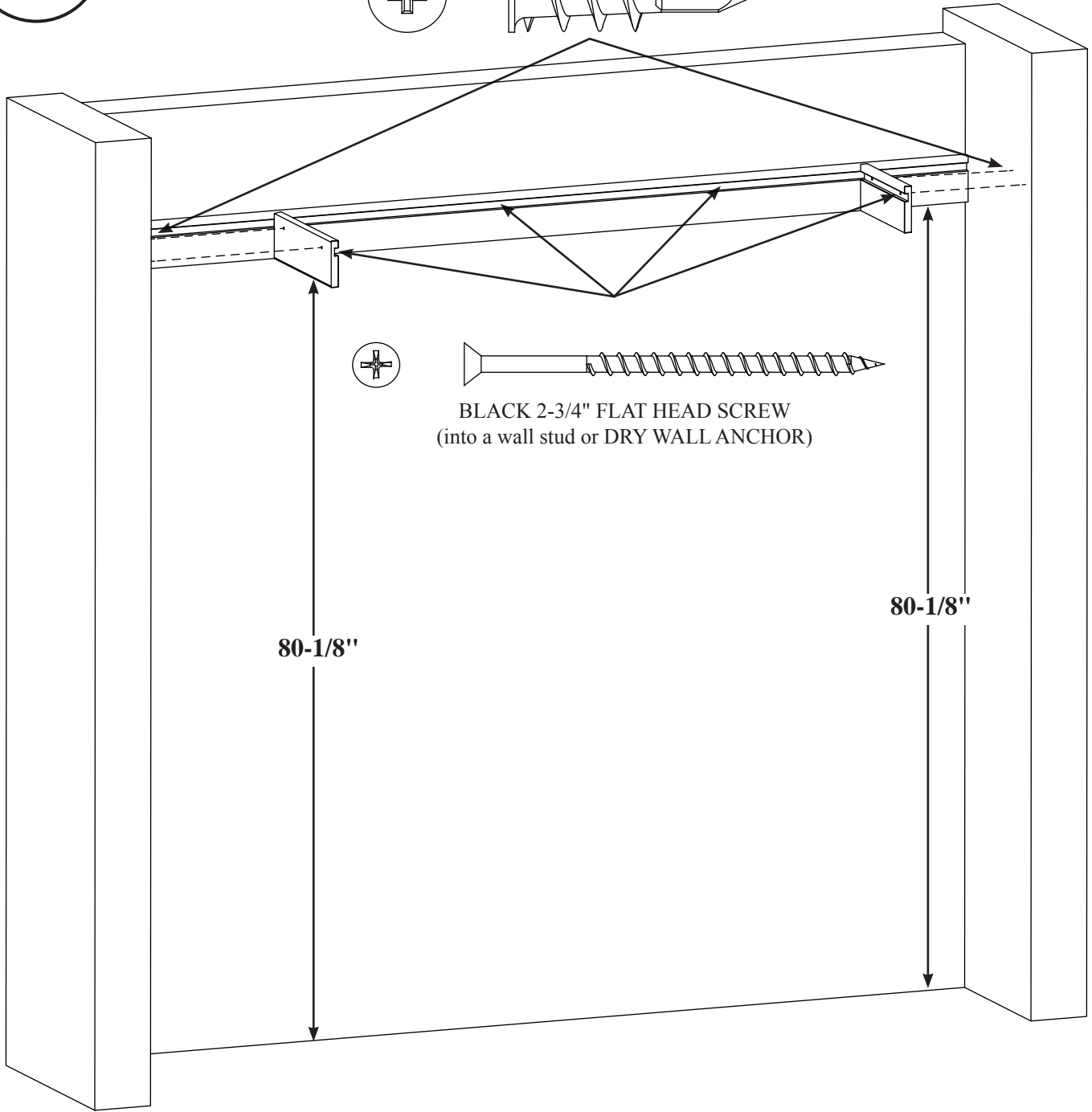
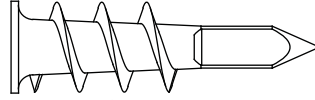
BLACK 9/16" LARGE HEAD SCREW (ANGLE BRACKET to an UPRIGHT, SHELF and SIDE CLEAT)



Screws are shown actual size. You may receive extra hardware with your unit.

DRYWALL ANCHOR



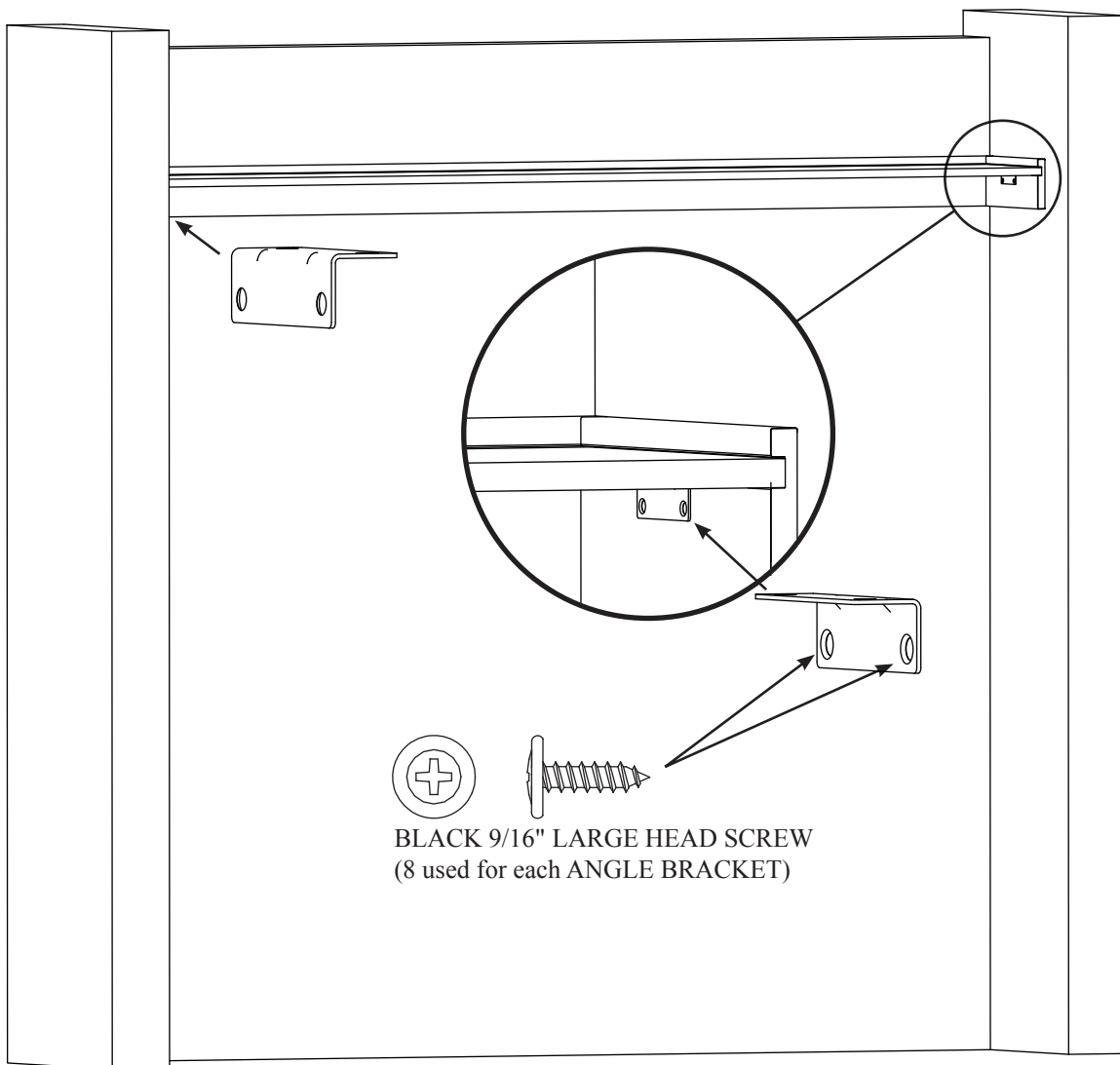
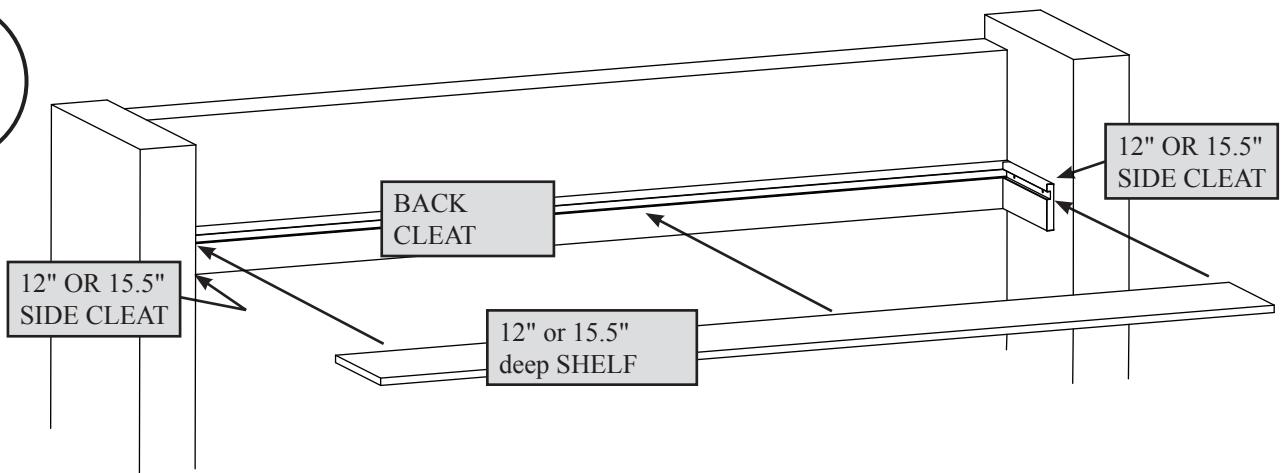
BLACK 2-3/4" FLAT HEAD SCREW
(into a wall stud or DRY WALL ANCHOR)

Cut to size a 96" BACK CLEAT and fasten it to the back wall 80-1/8" from the floor using a BLACK 2-3/4" FLAT HEAD SCREW through the groove of the BACK CLEAT and into all wall studs or a DRY WALL ANCHOR.

NOTE: Screws into wall studs must be 16" apart. If using DRY WALL ANCHORS only, they must be 12" apart.

Use DRY WALL ANCHORS and BLACK 2-3/4" FLAT HEAD SCREWS to fasten SIDE CLEATS to the wall.

Step

Cut to size a 96" SHELF and slide it into the grooves of the SIDE CLEATS and BACK CLEAT as shown in the upper diagram.

Fasten the SHELF to the SIDE CLEATS with two ANGLE BRACKETS and eight BLACK 9/16" LARGE HEAD SCREWS.

NOTE: If you are installing a closet rod, install Rod Support Brackets using the Rod Support Side Bracket Template, before installing ANGLE BRACKETS.

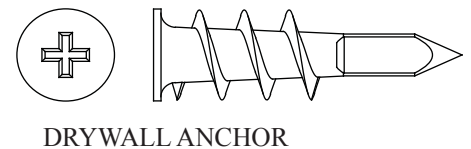
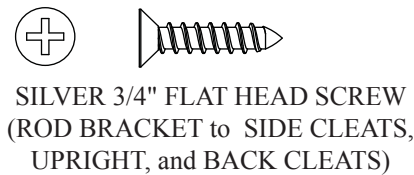
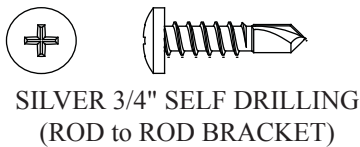
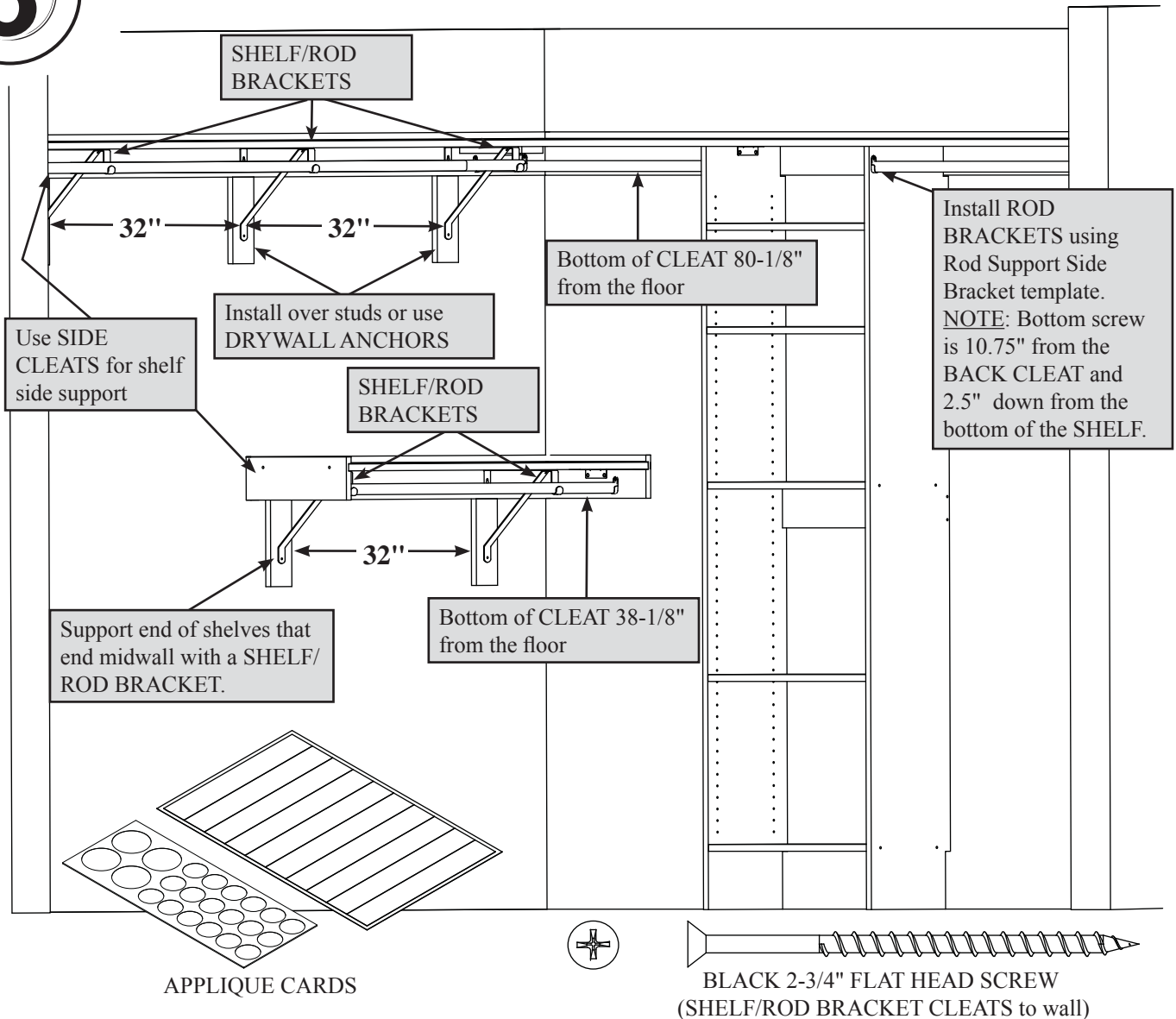
NOTE: If you purchased the Upright Pack and Adjustable Shelf/Brace Pack and/or the 24" Large Drawer Kit, see those Instruction booklets on how to install those components.

Step 3

RECOMMENDED MAXIMUM LOAD:

Installation into wall studs offers a recommended maximum weight capacity of 625 lbs or 78.125 lbs per foot.

Installation into drywall anchors offers a recommended maximum weight capacity of 625 lbs or 78.125 lbs per foot.



Fasten SHELF/ROD BRACKET CLEATS over the wall studs using a BLACK 2-3/4" FLAT HEAD SCREW and a DRYWALL ANCHOR if necessary.

Fasten SHELF/ROD BRACKETS with the SILVER 3/4" FLAT HEAD SCREWS ensuring that the SHELF is level.

Fasten ROD BRACKETS on SIDE CLEATS, UPRIGHTS or BACK CLEATS using the SILVER 3/4" FLAT HEAD SCREWS.

Fasten CLOSET RODS securing them with SILVER 3/4" SELF DRILLING SCREWS through SHELF/ROD BRACKETS.

Peel appliques from the APPLIQUE CARDS to cover screws and edges of SIDE CLEATS.

NOTE: Please read the back pages of the instruction booklet for important safety information.

This completes assembly. Clean with your favorite furniture polish or a damp cloth. Wipe dry.

If you cannot use a wall stud, use the supplied wall anchors into your drywall. <p>(If attaching the product to a wall made of concrete, plaster, or other material, purchase and use the appropriate mounting hardware. The attachment hardware must be rated to provide a minimum of 50 pounds of pull strength.)</p>
