

Grade C 1008 bright basic cold drawn steel wire with average tensile strength 100,000 PSI. All Steel wires shall be resistance welded at intersection of cross deck wires.

PRODUCT CARE

Use a non-abrasive damp cloth with mild soapy solution. Avoid excess water and dry the surface completely with compressed air or a dry lint free cloth after cleaning. Avoid harsh chemical cleaners.










