ENGINE SPECS

- 1) No forced induction engines
- 2) Commuter gas only
- 3) No nitrous, methanol, propane, or other power enhancing agents. If found using these you will be barred for the year.
- 4) Engine must be correct engine for that truck.
- 5) Must have stock fan in place.
- 6) If carbureted, no more than one carb allowed.
- 7) Engine and drive-train must be same size as mass produced and intended by vehicle manufacturer.
- 8) No non manufacturer engines (dodge must have dodge engine etc..)

OTHER SPECS

- 1) Must wear helmet.
- 2) Stock front and rear bumpers must be in factory location. Truck must be 100% legally inspectable (road legal).
- 3) Must have correct and up to date license plates for that vehicle.
- 4) Must have 4 working brakes.
- 5) All exterior lights must be in working order.
- 6) *May be* trailered in to pull.
- 7) Must be street legal exhaust and exit behind the cab-*No open exhaust*
- 8) Tires must be DOT approved, and be of street legal tread depth, they must be able to pass state inspection.
- 9) Reese style hitch preferred. Must have an opening of at least 3 inches. Clevices allowed, but must have 3 inches of useable opening when installed on truck. Otherwise the hook will not fit!
- 10) 26 inch hitch height max, and must be stable in all directions. No chains!
- 11) Springs no more than 3/8 inch thick each, and overall thickness no more than 4 inches.
- 12) Suspension must have 1 inch minimum travel
- 13) No air shocks, air bags, or coil-over springs.
- 14) No locked or limited front-ends
- 15) Must be factory wheel base.
- 16) No hidden weight in cab or in front of front bumper, <u>all added weight must be in the truck bed.</u> <u>No exceptions!</u>
- 17) Vehicle must be registered, inspected, and insured. Must show proof of registration and insurance at sign-up.
- 18) When class is called to line up, driver must stay with vehicle, or loose you're place in line.

Also -All General Safety Rules Apply! Violation of any rule will be a disqualification for the event in which the violation occurs and you will be asked to leave the event!
