How we are making Redditch AOG Safer

- Shorter services of less than 1 hour in duration
- Clear signage
- You will be shown to your seats
- You and your family bubble will be seated at least 1m+ from others
- Each row of seating is 2m apart
- A completed Covid-19 risk assessment has been done and available upon request
- Hand sanitizer is available in the corridor and toilets
- Doors and/or windows will be opened for extra ventilation
- Acrylic screens are in place for singer(s) and speakers
- Additional cleaning measures are in place in the church and toilets
- All books, toys, leaflets and pamphlets have been removed
- A parent & child room is available to entertain active little ones (1 family bubble at a time)
- Communion bread and wine will be served in the manufactured sealed packaging
- If you are required to do a reading or speak, your microphone must be cleaned by you after each use. Antibacterial wipes are available.
- The kitchen, minor hall and male toilets are temporarily closed.

How you can help

- To minimise disruption when the service has started, arrive 10-15 minutes before the service starts so that you can be shown to your seat. The service will start at 10:30 am
- Follow the social distancing measures inside and outside of the building
- Wear a mask or face covering
- If you wish, worship with raised hands, clapping, etc... but do not sing or shout
- As the kitchen is closed, bring your own bottled water to drink.
- Bring your own bible if required (However, bible verses and hymns are displayed on the TV screens in the church)
- Bring your own toys for young children (please ensure toys are not noisy)
- Put your tithes and offerings in the designated offering bag on entry or exiting the building
- At the end of the service, wait in your row until the steward indicates that your row can leave. (This will avoid any congregating in the aisles)
- Do not congregate in the car park in large groups and ensure the 2m social distance is observed on the church grounds.
- If you feel unwell and/or have any of these symptoms, continuous cough, high temperature, shortness of breath, please stay at home and visit us another time.
- If you are over 70 or fall within the governments' identified vulnerable groups, please follow the latest government advise before attending church services.
- Please also consider your safety in travelling to church i.e. Public Transport
