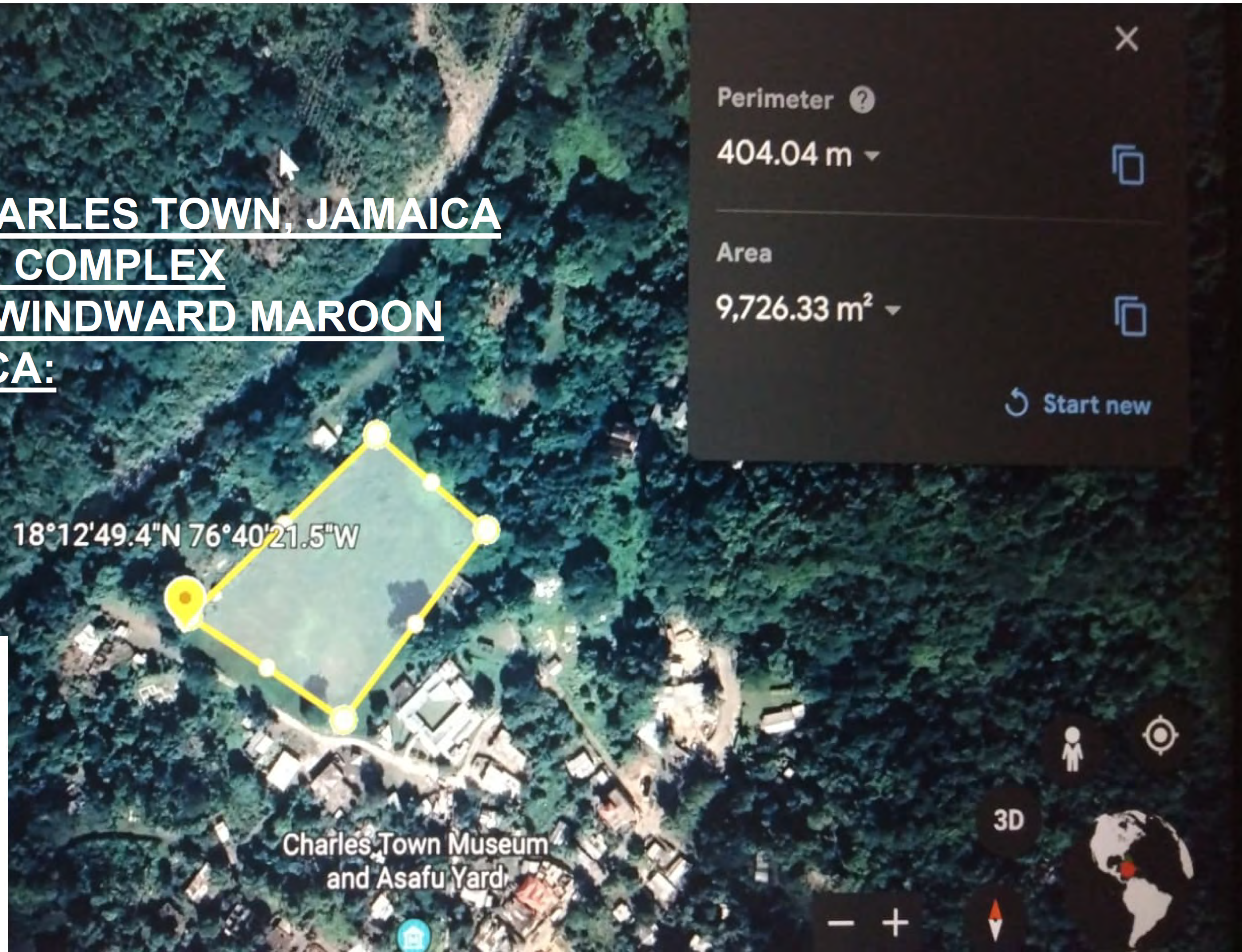

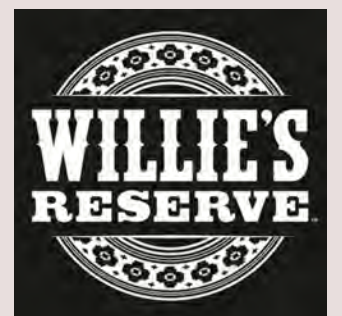

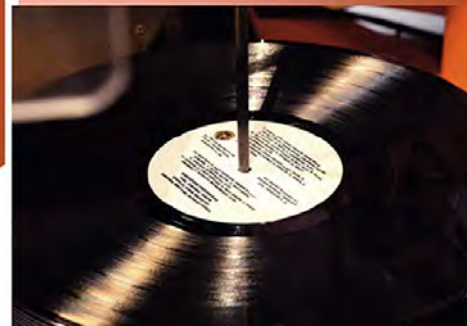

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS TO SHIP WINDWARD MAROON CANNABIS SEEDS OVERSEAS FROM JAMAICA TO LEGALLY APPROVED COUNTRIES:

1. PERMIT FOR INDIVIDUAL(S)
MAROON CANNABIS FARMERS.
2. HIGH QUALITY JAMAICAN MAROON
OUTDOOR CULTIVATED CANNABIS
SEEDS.
3. SMALL ZIPLOCK BAGS WITH
MAROON LABEL TO IDENTIFY AND
SHIP SEEDS.
4. ENVELOPES AND POSTAGE TO SHIP
CANNABIS SEEDS INSIDE LIVE
EVENT VINYL AND DVD SHIPPED
FROM JAMAICA.
5. PROCEEDS GO TO INDIGENOUS
RUN HERBAL CANCER RESEARCH
AND TREATMENT CENTER IN
