The kickoff is a music festival on Saturday, June 1st, at Fair Park, with an entrance fee. Over 200 vendors and several Main Stage acts are expected to begin at 11 am. The event also includes a Family Pride Zone with child-friendly activities and Teen Pride, which "fosters a safe environment for LGBTQ+ youth, ages 13 to 19", according to dallaspride.org.



On Sunday, the Dallas Pride Parade and Festival is FREE for all to enjoy! Vendors open at 10 am, while the grand parade starts at 2 pm and will be a barrage of inventive floats and colorful costumes, supporting the LGBTQ+ community in a mile-long event. Celebrations continue all month long with special features at the Dallas Comedy Club.
