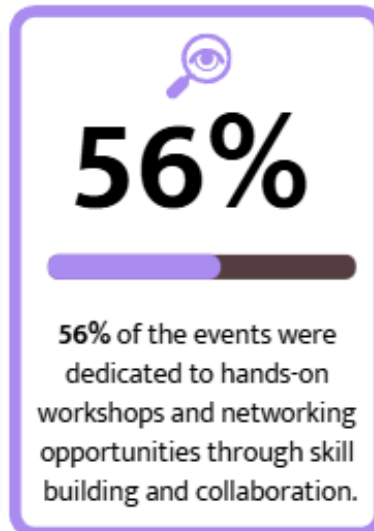
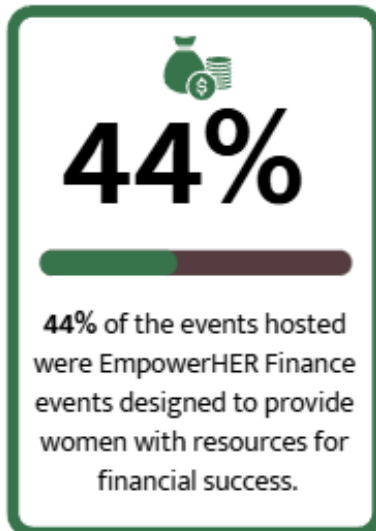
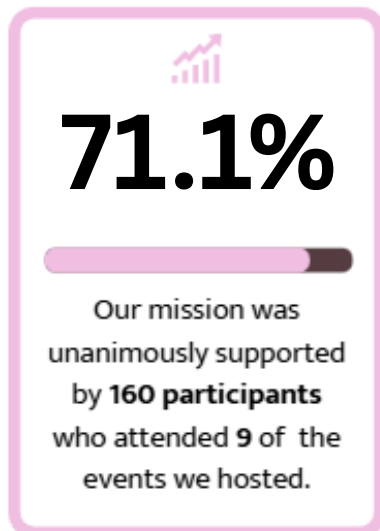

EmpowerHER Finance is a professional development and financial wellness series created to empower women of color with the knowledge, skills, and confidence to succeed personally and professionally. Each session is designed to inspire growth, encourage self-advocacy, and promote financial freedom, reflecting Sisters of Economic Action's commitment to empowering women and strengthening the local community.

Projects In Action

For the upcoming 2026 year, we are working towards a Nonprofit Women of Color Leaders Coalition called SEA Diasporic Wealth Cohort.



The Diasporic Wealth Cohort is a new initiative rooted in community, culture, and collective growth.



It is designed to help participants build financial confidence, develop wealth strategies, and strengthen economic mobility.



Through workshops, peer learning, and personalized coaching, participants gain tools and support to achieve their financial goals.



Open to individuals earning under \$45K in Cleveland launches Spring 2026.
