

Dear Honorable Holland,

Agency Tribal Nations doing business as Deganawidah-Quetzalcoatl University is serving notice of research training application in effect on Go Green Planet Initiative. Agency Tribal Nations focus will be social economic reform in for Native American Tribes and Chicanos. These two groups have strategic alliance with regards to Deganawidah-Quetzalcoatl University and in the implementation, development, advancement, training of this initiative.

However, the allocated funds to implement this have not been released. The lack of funding has set back the initiatives ability to provide services and goods to those who are in immediate need of economic help. In addition, the initiative brings education, vocational, research opportunities to those who have found it difficult to attain these goals.

Attached to this service packet are contracts/invoices that have not been paid out to initiative partners. Farmers have been hardest hit. Farming has increased in cost compared to the past few years. The lack of labor has been the problem. Initiative focuses on the research of *cannabis sativa* in all of its forms on the agronomic, economic, medical & educational impact on Native American Tribes and Chicanos.

The farms are severely behind schedule to produce the initiative requirement of 9 metric tons of *cannabis sativa* to be distributed in a first of first-of-its-kind federal tribal metric system.

The metric system is ready to enact now for Agency Tribal Nations LEGAL federal distribution into 37 states. Agency Tribal Nations is set to issue 13,000 first-of-its-kind Agency Tribal Nations Distribution Licenses throughout said 37 states.

Agency Tribal Nations will franchise first-of-its-kind shipping container dispensaries along with Deganawidah-Quetzalcoati University medical research associates and co- operative extension agreements to universities associated with these tribal partners.

All Agency Tribal Nations cultivation, distribution, transportation, manufacturing and retail medical research licenses shall be subject to rigorous application process and will be licensed, bonded and insured.

The initiative will allow for Agency Tribal Nations and initiative partners like Salinas Valley Ag Monitoring LLC. to implement the goal of cooperative extensions with tribes within these 37 states. Agency Tribal Nations and its initiative partners will provide goods in the form genetics, Standard Operating Procedures, Agronomy, Integrated Pest Management, Farm management, labor management to the tribes. In return the farming will provide economic stimulation in the sales of the product to the Agency Tribal Nations and the finished goods entering the federal *cannabis sativa* metric system.

Partnering with the tribes to develop dispensaries in tribal areas that can further produce jobs and economic stimulation in the community.

We have faith that you will recognize the peril that this imitative is in without your help. The groundwork for this initiative has been implemented on scarce resources. We have absolute confidence that with your ability to push funding through as soon as possible, the initiative will be able to produce positive results within a short period of time. We urge you to recognize the potential this initiative has and its long term benefits to the Native American Tribal nations and Chicano nation.
