



Hanger Offset Kit - Single


To install Single Hanger Offset Kit onto your existing target stands, first remove the hook assembly as shown below. Next, install the spacer tubes and hook using the provided 4" carriage bolts. Tighten the nuts to 1/16 turn past snug. Do not over-torque.





T-post Hangers can also be adapted to the Hanger Offsets. Install per the images below. Tighten nuts to 1/16 turn past snug. Note: Shown on the left is the optional removal of the extension bracket. These are not needed when using offsets.





<u>Single Hanger Offset Replacement hardware</u> - If replacement hardware is needed for your Single Hanger Offset Kit, see the following list of parts to source:


- 1/4-20 Carriage Bolt, Grade 5 or 8, 4" Length (qty 2)
- 1/4-20 Nylon Lock Nut, Grade 5 or 8 (gty 2)




Hanger Offset Kit – Double

To install Double Hanger Offset Kit onto your existing target stands, first remove the hook assembly as shown below. Next, install the spacer tubes and hooks using the provided 7.5" carriage bolts. Tighten the nuts to 1/16 turn past snug. Do not over-torque.










You have the option to use the Double Hanger Offset Kit in one of two ways, either use 2 hooks (one on each side of the upright) or use a single hook, but spaced twice as far from the upright. This option is great for larger target sizes.

<u>T-post Hangers</u> can also be adapted to the Double Hanger Offset Kit. Install per the images below. Tighten nuts to 1/16 turn past snug. Note: Shown on the left is the optional removal of the extension bracket. These are not needed when using offsets.







<u>Replacement hardware</u> - If replacement hardware is needed for your Hanger Offset Kit, see the following list of parts to source:

- 1/4-20 Carriage Bolt, Grade 5 or 8, 7.5" Length (qty 2)
- 1/4-20 Nylon Lock Nut, Grade 5 or 8 (qty 2)
- 1/2" DOM or Schedule 40 tubing, cut to 3.1" (qty 4)
