

If assembled correctly, and placed on solid ground, you should experience zero target failures for many matches to come. Enjoy your new targets, and we hope your next match is a success!


Assemble per the images below. **Tighten nuts with a hand tool to 1/16 turn past snug**. *We do not recommend using a power tool for tightening nuts to their final torque, as this may cause hardware damage due to over-torquing, or loose parts due to under-torquing.*




<u>Leg Locker Assembly</u> – The leg locker (shown above in black) is a handy feature that locks the two legs together. Once installed, it can be locked and unlocked by hand, without the use of tools. Assemble per the images above. <u>When tightening the leg locker, tighten the nut until snug, then loosen the nut by 1 full turn</u>. This will allow the locker to rotate freely for toolless operation.

<u>Base Angle Options</u> – When you assemble the bases, you will have the option to change the base angles, depending on the slope of the ground or berm where the target will be placed. The front angle can be adjusted by moving the bottom upright bolt to a different slot in the angle adjustment feature. The side angle can be adjusted by using a different slot in the side base. *Note, the leg locker can be installed in any of the three side base angle locations (see top right picture)*.

Optional Wingnuts – When installing the bases, you have the option to use the provided locking wingnuts. These enable toolless setup and takedown of bases at the range. The image on the left shows how to install the base onto the upright by sliding it in at an angle. Note, you'll want to first make sure that your wingnuts are both in a horizontal position to allow them to pass through the openings. Torque to 1/16 turn past snug. When tightening the wing nuts, feel free to use a target like a flathead screwdriver to provide more torque when tightening. However, be careful to not overtighten, as this could damage the wingnuts.



<u>Bumper Washer Installation</u> – Each of your stands should include 3 washers to be used as a target bumper. <u>Early shipments did not include bumpers</u>, so if you did not receive them, please contact us and we can ship them to you at no <u>cost</u>. The bumper is required for use with the 1" target to prevent the target from getting stuck on the side of the extension bracket. We recommend just installing bumpers on all your stands during setup. Here is the correct bumper orientation. Torque to 1/16 turn past snug. <u>Note: make sure the bumpers are on the same side as the hook!</u>



Replacement hardware - If replacement hardware is needed, see the following list of off-the-shelf parts to source:

- 1/4-20 Carriage Bolt, 3/4" Length, Grade 5 or 8
- 1/4-20 Nylon Lock Nut, Grade 5 or 8
- 1/4-20 Nylon Lock Wingnut
- 1/4 x 1-1/2 Fender Washer
