

Hanson Riding Club Virtual Horse Show

Fees

\$10 per class

There is an additional fee of \$15 to enter this show if you are not a member of Hanson Riding Club. You can also join HRC at this time and skip the non-member fee.

Each horse and rider combination should complete this [Google Form](#) with rider/horse info and classes entered. Memberships can be added there too.

All fees may be paid via Venmo – @HansonRidingClub or you can mail a check made out to “HRC” to 218 Old Main St. Lakeville, MA 02347

You must list the Facebook name, horse and rider name in the Venmo note section or in a note with the check.

There will be no refunds for missing videos or missed deadlines.

Once paid, the Facebook user will be invited to the virtual show group. Each class will have its own album and albums will be posted one week before the show deadline. The user can then upload videos to the correct albums, make sure to list horse, rider and class number. Videos in wrong classes will be removed.

Each class must have its own video submitted, riders may not use the same video for more than one class.

This is our first virtual show and we love that you want to participate. We'd like to limit the confusion of mailing things but we also know some love their ribbons so we are offering a choice of receiving a ribbon or receiving a payback in the form of credit towards our next LIVE horse show. We will place 1st-6th in each class.

If you choose to receive ribbons there will be a flat fee \$5 per rider for postage/packaging. If you choose the payback option, we will be awarding \$5 in credit for first place, \$3 in credit for second place and \$1 in credit for third place. All credits will expire at the end of 2021 as long as we have live shows in 2021.

We will also be offering prizes for the High Point Senior Exhibitor, High Point Junior Exhibitor and High Point Walk/Trot Exhibitor. (This will be based on the exhibitor only, they may show multiple horses in different classes.)

If this virtual show is a success, we will discuss more shows and prize options in the future.

Rules

Show tack and attire is not required, but you are more than welcome to show in that. However, we do ask that horse and rider are neat and tidy. Tack should be discipline appropriate and riders should wear clothes that are professional and form fitting so that we can actually judge fairly.

Training devices are not allowed.

Please follow the specs for each class when creating your video. If rules are not followed, the video could be deleted or DQ'ed

Riders 18 and under are required to wear a helmet
Riders may only enter each class once.

Videos must state rider name and horse name when posting

Videos must be clear, unedited and have sound ON

Video must be posted in the class album by 9PM on June 27th 2020.
Results will be posted in the group one week after the show deadline.

Class albums will be up a week before the show begins on

Riders may get feedback via private messenger.

We encourage positive comments and encouragement on videos.

Negative or inappropriate posts will be taken down

Judges decisions are final
Walk Trot riders cannot enter any under saddle canter/lope classes

Please refer to HRC rules for all other rules and division specs.

Classes & Videos

Halter - horse should trot from one marker to a second marker in a straight line for about 10 seconds, turn and continue trotting for another 10 seconds then halt and square up. Then take a 10 second video of all four sides.

Showmanship - pattern should be recorded including the inspection. Please refer to pattern for specifics of where videographer should stand.

Equitation – horse and rider should show 15-20 seconds of all the required gaits in both directions.

Pleasure – horse and rider should show 15-20 seconds of all the required gaits in both directions along with a halt from the fastest gait and a back of 3-4 steps.

Horsemanship pattern classes - pattern should be recorded from start to finish. Please refer to pattern for specifics of where recorder should stand.

Trail - we realize that everyone will have different types of poles, obstacles and jumps. This is meant to be a FUN event, and we do not want anyone to feel they can't join in, so please take note that all videos will look a little different

Patterns will be posted ONE MONTH before the show to allow enough time for riders to prepare and video
