WEDNESDAY, MAY 29TH: 5 PM-7 PM Last Rehearsal before the Parade. Please


wear a long sleeved western shirt, denim pants, and your hat.

Groups reservations are not permitted so members must make their own individual arrangements when PVMR post dates for camping on the yearly calendar.






