Newsletter: Laura Precoda requested that we send photos for "Horsing Around & "When We Were Younger" to submit to the newsletter. Laura also reminded members that the membership will be voting to amend club by-laws regarding a new voting app available that would increase club participation when we vote. The voting app. will be used as a trial run in July, so heads up.



OLD BUSINESS:

- Tack Sale: Saturday, September 27 at Hawthorne Feed in Santee; the tack sale will include tack, crafts, anything you may have that you would like to get rid of. The Call Tree will be making phone calls in July to remind club members. Susan P. said she would pick up items in August if someone wanted to donate. Article VII. ELECTIONS

Section 7.01 Nominating Committee

In September of each year, a nominating committee of three shall be appointed by the President of the corporation. Said committee will contact members to seek those interested in holding an office. In October of each year, a slate of eligible persons to serve as officers and Directors of the corporation shall be presented to the membership at large during the regular monthly meeting.

Section 7.02 Time of Elections

During the last regularly scheduled meeting of the year (November), nominations from the floor shall be called for and elections held. Voting will be held in person at the last yearly meeting and incorporate a private online voting app option to increase member participation. Newly elected officers shall be installed and take office at the first general meeting of the New Year and shall serve until the new officers are installed the next year.




