

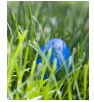

## *Letter from the editor:*

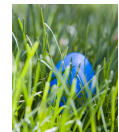
*Come ride the inviting trails this month! Enjoy the adventures as Spring is in full swing!*

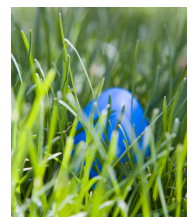

## *Hollenbeck Canyon Wildlife Area-History*

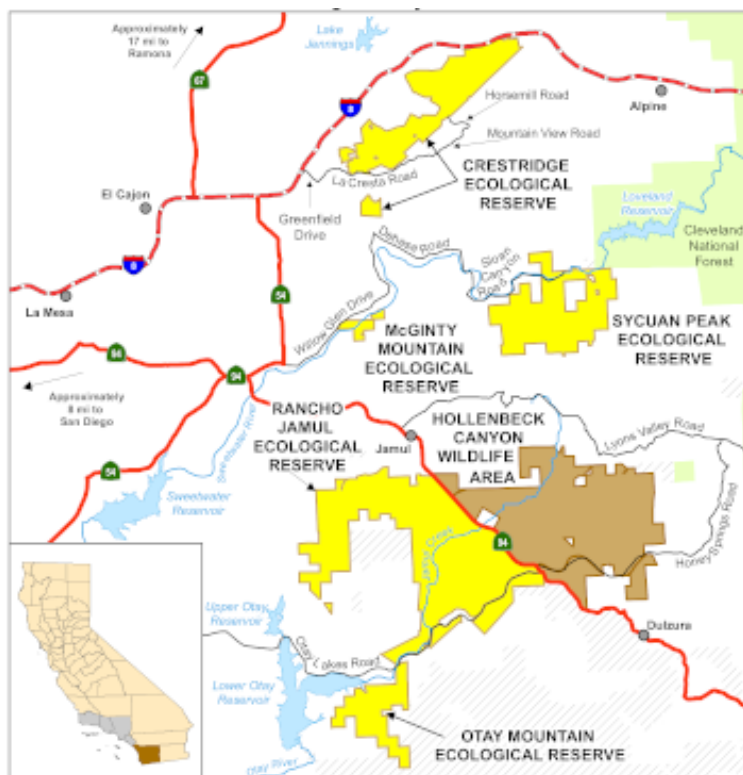
In 1831, the Jamul Valley was granted to Pio Pico (former governor of California) as Rancho Jamul. The Burton family occupied the land after Pio Pico, but lost their title at the end of the 1850s. Several farmers began to settle believing it was government land available for homesteading.

In the late 1890s, a San Diego entrepreneur gained control of the land. He sold the property to the former San Diego Mayor in 1916. In 1929, the property was purchased and turned into a cattle ranch, which it remained until acquisition by the

Department. The property was designated as a wildlife area by the Fish and Game Commission in 2001.

The approximately 6,100-acre Hollenbeck Canyon Wildlife Area provides a wildlife corridor between Otay Mountain and the Jamul Mountains. Habitat includes coastal sage scrub, chaparral, oak woodlands, riparian forests, freshwater marshes, and grasslands. Elevation ranges from a low of 750' to 2,100' at the highest peak.

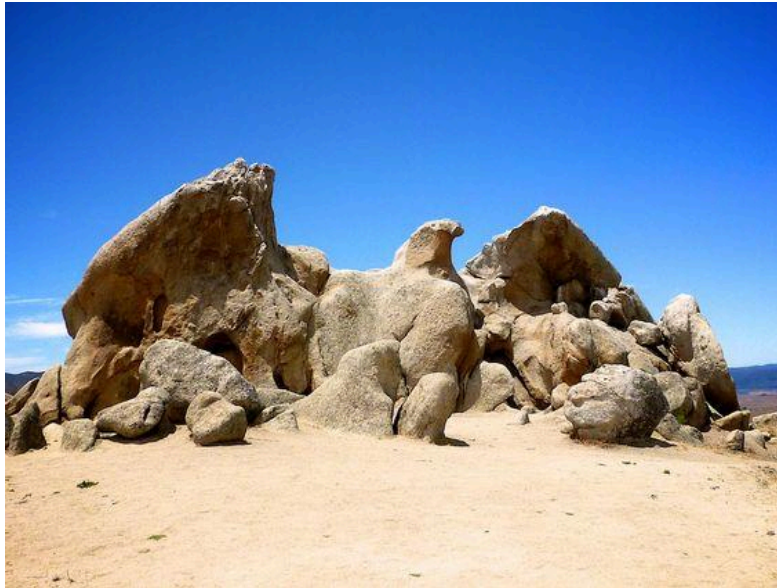

## ***Eagle Rock*** is a Massive Sand Stone Formation



resembling an enormous eagle with its wings spread wide in a glorious position that looks as though the bird is ready to take flight. The wind created this spectacular phenomenon over thousands of years. It is situated on the Pacific Crest Trail and it is a sacred site to the local Cupa and Cahuilla peoples. The Cupa were forcibly removed from their ancestral lands at nearby Warner Springs in 1903.

Early settlers referred to the site as *La Piedra Gorda* (Fat Rock) but has been known as *Eagle Rock* since at least 1888. The trail passes through oak trees, open grassland, and a stream. The trail to the landmark is approximately a little over 6 miles round trip.

# *History of The CrestRidge Ecological Reserve*

**PART 1: The Crestridge Ecological Reserve is a 3,000 acre reserve owned by the California Department of Fish and Wildlife and managed by the Endangered Habitats Conservancy.**

The reserve is bounded on the north by Interstate 8, on the east by Harbinson Canyon, on the south by Mountain View and La Cresta Roads, and on the southwest by La Cresta Road.

Once the site of a Kumeyaay Indian Village, it includes three prehistoric archeological sites. The Crestridge property was known as “Oakridge.” It was once the home of the Cornelius family in the early 1920s. Sometime before World War II, Colonel Ed Fletcher bought the “S” Tract of Rancho El Cajon. Mr. Buck Rickles worked for the Ed Fletcher Company, Inc from 1963 to 1976, and raised his family on the property. Rickles and Mr. Waller, who was the handyman for the Ed Fletcher Company, had cows, horses and various other livestock, mostly in the area of the avocado grove, just beyond the reserve. Mr. Waller cleared the area that is now annual grassland north of the oak grove on the reserve, erected fences, and used to raise quarter horses. None of the rest of the property was cleared.

During the 1990s, plans were approved by San Diego County for residential development. In response to the development proposal, the citizens of Crest formed the Crest Open Space Supporters and the Back Country Land Trust to advocate for conservation of the property as open space and incorporation into the County of San Diego MSCP preserve system. The Crest Open Space Supporters contacted the Endangered Habitat League in 1998 about preserving the property, which had an approved 92-lot subdivision. From 1998-2000. EHL negotiated the sale of Crestridge from the owner Frank Gatlin. The property was sold to the California Department of Fish and Game in 2000.
