

2023 Thanxchirmsukkah – Vendor Details

Event Basics: Thanxchirmsukkah takes place on Saturday, December 2nd from 10:00am – 2:00pm. Setup begins at 8:30am and breakdown begins at 2:00pm. The parking lot location is: 13651 N. 32nd Street, 85032 (SE corner of Thunderbird Rd. and 32nd Street in The Rock shopping complex).

Event Details: There will be kids' crafts, a photo booth, hotdogs, henna tattoos, bake sale, 50/50 cash raffle, face-painting, and local vendors. The event is free, but tickets are sold for food and kids activities. Ticket sales benefit Grounded32 (grounded32.org). Four other Arizona nonprofits will be present, and we encourage vendors to visit their booths and see what they're about! **All event details, including downloadable flyers, can be found on superradevent.com.**

Who Should Buy a Booth? Booths are for local businesses selling products (such as T-shirts, homemade jams, candles, etc.) and local nonprofit charities engaging in outreach. If you are a nonprofit information booth, please offer an engaging activity or items for sale to ensure the event is fun and interactive. **Please do not solicit cash donations during the event** – since Grounded32 hosts only two fundraisers per year, we hope as many donations as possible will be allocated to Grounded32 programs so we can stay open through 2024.

Cost + Purchase Info: We request a \$100 donation per 10x10 vendor space. To reserve a booth space, visit superradevent.com and click "BUY A BOOTH." If you'd like to reserve two spaces, please donate \$200. **Make sure to select the drop down option "Reserve a Vendor Booth" and include your full name, phone number, and business name in the memo line of your donation.** Once you pay the reservation donation, your email address and phone number will be added to our vendor list. We will contact you 1 week prior to confirm your participation and answer any questions you may have.

Setup/Cleanup + Parking: Bring your own tent, tables, chairs, trash bins, and water. Set up begins at 8:30am and clean up begins at 2:00pm. **Do NOT leave your car parked in the primary parking lot. Park behind the complex (the back of Genesis Church). There is a separate entrance to the back parking lot off 32nd Street just East of Thunderbird Rd. If this lot is full, we suggest parking in the surrounding neighborhoods or near Vasa Gym.** The event will be set up in front of Genesis Church under a large, covered parking structure near the middle of the parking lot. Once you arrive, ask for Rachel Curry. I will be wearing a name tag and something obnoxious for easy identification.

Bathrooms + ATM: There are bathrooms inside Grounded32, Studio164, No Filter Coffee Shop, and Original Breakfast House. There is an ATM inside Original Breakfast House.

Cool Stuff for Vendors: Vendors get a free lunch (hotdog or vegan option, chips, and soda), a Grounded32 sticker, a chance to make new friends, and tons of high-fives! Our volunteers are super nice, and some of them look like supermodels.
