Over the past 5 years, we have not lost sight of our founding values. For Surf & Turf, inclusion means breaking down barriers and making sure programs are accessible to all. 

Grow surf therapy and therapeutic surfing programs to meet the current need, by offering 20% more service hours in these areas and reducing waitlist





Throughout the year, we were able to host a series of impactful events centered around community and inclusion. At RX3 a flag football team, lead by Emerson Roth & NFL Quarterback "DTR", set the tone for a year of philanthropy and collaboration. Our inaugural pickleball event, spearheaded by dedicated volunteer Heather Alkon, was a tremendous success and welcomed new friends to our community. The San Diego Chapter hosted their first event, sharing the stoke with 12 surfers, including current patients and their loved ones for a memorable "friends and family day." The Surf and Turf-a-Thon, spanned an entire weekend with participants eager to catch waves and ride laps while raising over \$20,000 to support our mission. The 4th annual Movie with a Mission brought together 300+ community members for a FREE event thanks to presenting sponsor ROTH Capital. The day at the ranch was filled with entertainment, including line dancing with Marie Kelly and a drive-in showing of Cars! Silver Horseshoe award winning summer camps, sold out all five sessions and provided a week of fun and function for participants. At the Velzy contest with the Doheny Longboard Surfing Association, 14 surfers competed in front of a supportive crowd alongside peers. The 4th annual Chukkers for Charity event at the scenic OC Polo Club surpassed expectations, raising over \$126,000- a remarkable achievement attributed to the generous contributions of sponsors like Hot Ticket Racing and the compelling stories shared by program participants Grace Sheehan and Dylan Law. The year concluded with the festive Santa paddle hosted by Stacy Savage, bringing together supporters for a morning of paddling followed by a volunteer training—a perfect culmination of a year dedicated to community, compassion, and service!
