




Vietnamese RF/PF compound located in Ben Tre Province






Mike "chilling out" after a rocket attack. Notice the pock marks on the building to his right.




Mike with a local boy in Ham Long.

Local festival celebration spotted on trip to Saigon.




Couple of RF/PF kids in our compound.




Looked up from the table in our sleeping area while writing a letter. She was standing there. Daughter of local soldier. She was my friend.



Twenty dollars in local currency. Don't know how it made it home.




RF/PF outpost along the Mekong River near Ham Long.
