

**City of Paisley**  
**Special Council Meeting**  
**Minutes of April 20th, 2026**  
**6:30 pm at City Hall**

- **Call to Order** Pursuant to notice published on the city website: [www.cityofpaisley.net](http://www.cityofpaisley.net), and notice published at the Paisley Post office and given to members of the Council, the Regular Council Meeting of the City of Paisley was held on April 20th, 2026, at Paisley City Hall. Mayor Keith Harra (via Zoom) called the meeting to order at 6:28 pm. Council members in attendance were Stu Burgess (via Zoom), Len Babb III, and Trina Negus. Others in attendance were Shelia Babb, recording minutes.

**Business:** Well Update: Given the lack of water found in the well, it was suggested that the City not move forward with additional well development and use remaining funds for water line replacement. We cannot leave Well as is but we can leave it in a state where it can be used in the future and remain an asset for the city. There are 2 options: 1 where we can drill deeper in the future and 2<sup>nd</sup> where we could try to utilize the upper water bearing layer. In both cases, the well needs to be sealed to prevent cross-aquifer contamination. Option 1: Leaving the well for future deeper drilling. This entails: Sealing the well to the bottom of the 10” casing, 272ft. below ground. Removing the 14” casing. Disinfecting the well. Capping the well. Option 2: Leaving the well for future development of the upper water bearing layer. This entails: It would be better to develop the well at this elevation rather than pay for another mobilization cost in the future. They suggest that this option would be risky since the water gallons per minute are substantially lower than what we need and the arsenic levels are higher than what we wanted. If we move forward with this option, the bottom open hole would be filled, and we would not be able to dig deeper later. Len Babb III motions that the city go with Option 1, leaving the well for future drilling options. Trina Negus 2nds the

motion. Voting aye: Len Babb III, Trina Negus, Keith Harra, and Stu Burgess.  
Voting nay: none, motion carries

- Community Center Keys: Missy Walton is wanting a copy of the community center keys with the Mosquito Festival meetings. Stu Burgess suggested giving her keys until August when Mosquito Festival is over.
- A property owner contacted Shelia Babb at City Hall this morning about her property she is trying to sell. She moved away in November of 2025 and didn't pay her bill and didn't give a forwarding address. She wanted her water turned back on so they could show the house. Stu suggested going through maybe the title company or realtor to get those fees paid before water can be turned back on. Make sure to get her forwarding address.
