**Work Session Council Meeting**  
**Minutes of June 15, 2026**  
**6:30 pm at City Hall**

- **Call to Order** Pursuant to notice published on the city website: [www.cityofpaisley.net](http://www.cityofpaisley.net), and notice published at the Paisley Post office and given to members of the Council, the Work Session Council Meeting of the City of Paisley was held on June 15, 2026, at Paisley City Hall. Paisley Mayor Keith Harra called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm. Council members in attendance were Len Babb III, and Trina Negus. Others in attendance were Lizzie Hyde and Shelia Babb, recording minutes.
  
- **Public Comment:** Lizzie Hyde came before the council on behalf of her parents Taylor & Becky Hyde who have property at 150 Green st. who want to change lot lines on their property. She showed maps of the property and exactly what they wanted to do. Keith Harra motioned to accept Lizzie Hyde's request to change lot lines, Len Babb III 2<sup>nd</sup>. Voting aye: Keith Harra, Len Babb III, and Trina Negus. Voting nay: none, motion carries.
  
- **Business:** Keith Harra made a motion to enact the following Resolution No. 2025-26-01 (061526) and adopt the budget for fiscal year 2026-2027 in the amount of \$3,001,742. General Fund at \$186,490, Street Fund at \$323,938 (contains fund for Road repair), Water/Sewer at \$2,448,648 (contains funds for water line project), Debt service Fund at \$13,000 and Mosquito Festival Fund at \$24,840. Unappropriated amount of \$4,826 for a total of \$3,001,742. The Resolution imposes a tax in the amount of \$0.00 OR at the rate of \$1.5739 per \$1,000 of assessed value for permanent tax rate. Also declaring the city elections to receive state revenues. Trina Negus 2<sup>nd</sup>. Voting aye: Len Babb III, Trina Negus, and Keith Harra. Voting nay: none; motion carries.
